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MSA MOTOCROSS NATIONAL CIRCULAR 01 OF 2017

Please note below amendments to the 2017 National Motocross Standing Supplementary Regulations:

SSR 234 (B) : FALSE/ JUMP STARTS

Amendment to the penalties –

Any rider who in the opinion of the Clerk of the Course gained an advantage by jumping the start gate will be black-flagged and be required to stop where a time stop penalty of 10 seconds will be imposed, or a 20 second penalty added to the telemetry system results for his/her final position where telemetry is used be penalised a minimum of a 20 second penalty for the first offence. Second offence at the same event, rider will be excluded.

SSR 235 (C) ii : GENERAL

Removal of the below wording -

ii) At National Championship events where transponders are used the rider will be shown a penalty board displaying his number. A time penalty will be enforced at the end of the race. The time penalty will be a minimum of 20 seconds added to his race time and/or additional penalties at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course and/or Stewards. Should a rider receive a further penalty during the race, he will be asked to leave the track. Penalties will be at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

SSR 242 : ENTRIES

Amendment of the below wording

The entry fee for National Championship events will be a maximum of *R1350 incl. excl. VAT* for Junior and Senior riders for the first class entered and includes a transponder.

Should a rider enter more than one class, the entry fee for that class (i.e. second class) for Junior and Senior riders will be a maximum of *R850.00 incl.* excl. VAT which also includes a transponder.

SSR 243 (8) : CLASSES AND ELIGIBILITY OF MOTORCYCLES AND RIDERS Amendment to the MX3 class -

How MX 3 Works at Nationals for 2017:

- MX 3 class will score twice on race day.
- Riders will score once in the National Championship MX3 class. It is compulsory to score in this class by all MX3 entrants. It remains an official National Championship class recognized by MSA. MSA only recognizes this class for National Championship status.
- All MX3 entrants then score a second time in an age specific category for 'on the day' purposes only. You cannot enter and score only in the age specific categories.
- Riders are required to have a National Licence.

- National Entry Fee applies BUT riders only pay for First Class entry. Riders are not charged a second class entry fee to score in both.
- All MX 3 riders race together in their own race. It will not be combined with any other classes unless numbers are less than 10
- There is a National podium for MX3 and then 5 (five) additional Top 3 podiums for the age specific categories below (actual age on race day):
 - 30 34
 - 35 39 40 – 44
 - 40 44 45 – 49
 - 50+
- Bonus points as in previous years are discontinued.
- Prize money and trophies are given to the Top 3 in the National Championship Class and trophies will be given to the Top 3 in each age specific 'on the day' categories.

SSR 243 (9) : CLASSES AND ELIGIBILITY OF MOTORCYCLES AND RIDERS Amendment to the MX2 Stroke class – Age – Open to riders from the year of the 18th birthday From 125cc and over

NOTE 9 :

Amendment to the combining of classes -

The 65cc/85cc *Jnr, and 125cc/Pro Mini* classes may be combined at the discretion of the COC at Regional or Club events only.

SSR 248 : MANUFACTURERS TROPHY

Amendment to the wording -

Points will be awarded to the top *three* finishing motorcycle of each manufacturers from the *MX High School*, MX1 and MX2 classes aggregated.

To establish a Manufacturer Champion, points will be awarded to each manufacturer for its highest placed finisher in each class
