





SPORTING & TECHNICAL REGULATIONS FOR THE RAND KART CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP 2019 (161731/144)

The purpose of the Championship is to declare Rand Kart Club Champions in the various classes. All competitors are welcome to participate and score. It needs to be understood that the emphasis is encouraging newcomers and club racing competitors. For this reason certain Club Classes have been created. Furthermore, the overall point scoring is designed to challenge the top competitors and favour the beginners and amateurs.

1. CONTROLLERS

Will be Rand Kart Club and their committee

The controllers reserve the right, without prior notice, to introduce and / or amend the existing regulations should circumstances warrant. All additions/amendments will be published on the Official Notice board and where possible circulated to competitors prior to any event.

VALIDITY OF THESE REGULATIONS

Applicable for the calendar year 2019

3. REGULATIONS

In so far as is applicable, all race meetings shall be held under the 2019 General Competition Rules (GCR's) and Standing Supplementary Regulations (SSR's) of Motorsport South Africa (MSA), the 2019 MSA Karting Regulations, these Sporting Regulations and the Supplementary Regulations issued by the promoters / organizers, plus any relevant 2019 MSA Bulletins / Circulars together with any additional instructions issued to competitors by the Organizers or MSA.

AIM OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP

To declare a Rand Kart Club Club Champions in the following classes:

- a. Bambino
- b. Micro Max
- c. 60cc Clubmans (Maxterino/Mini Rok)
- d. Mini Max
- e. Junior Max
- f. Max 175 / Clubmans
- g. Senior Max
- h. DD2 Clubmans

5. CHAMPIONSHIP RACE MEETINGS















The championship will consist of six rounds of three heats each at Zwartkops:

- a. 19 January 2019
- b. 18 May 2019
- c. 13 July 2019
- d. 7 September 2019
- e. 5 October 2019
- f. 30 November 2019

ELIGIBILITY OF DRIVERS

- 6.1 A minimum of an MSA Karting club license is required
- 6.2 All are welcome to participate in the events but only members of Rand Kart Club will be able to score in the Club Championship.

7. EQUIPMENT

The above listed championship classes will use equipment, weights and ages as per the 2019 MSA Karting National Regulations as well as the technical regulations for the individual classes which can be found on MSA's website and www.kart.co.za.

The only exceptions are set out in the points below:

6.1. 60cc Clubmans

- Maxterino as previously homologated a.
- Maxterino minimum weight 100kg b.
- Maxterino tyres Mojo C2 c.
- d. Mini Rok to current MSA specifications

6.2. Clubmans Class:

- Clubmans Class will race and score in Max 175 and basically run to the same rules. a.
- b. Clubmans must enter events as clubmans to be recognised in the rescoring.
- c. To be eligible for Clubmans only Rotax pre EVO engines must be used. The only exceptions are conrods, pistons and cylinders as these are no longer available as spare parts.
- d. The minimum age is year of the 16th birthday
- The minimum weight is 170kg e.
- f. Current or previously MSA approved chassis minimum of three years old
- The Clubmans class championship is only open to competitors not participating in g. the 2019 Karting Regional and/or National Championships. Any competitor deciding to participate at a higher level will be excluded from the Clubmans Class championship. The points scored up to that point in MAX 175 will be retained.

6.3. DD2 Clubmans Class:

Minimum mass 180kg

QUALIFYING & GRID POSITIONS

Qualifying

- Qualifying will be by a 10 minute timed session.
- Timing will be by means of an MSA approved timing system.

Grids / Starting Positions

- Heat 1 (one) starting positions will be based on fastest lap times achieved in qualifying
- Heat 2 (two) starting position will be based on fastest lap times achieved in Heat 1.
- Heat 3 (three) starting positions will be based on fastest lap times achieved in Heat 2.

9. POINT SCORING

- 9.1 Non-RKC members may participate in the events and win prizes on the day. This means that the first RKC member on the day will not necessarily score full points. In other words, your position on the road will determine the number of points scored.
- 9.2 Points will be scored as follows 35, 32, 30, 29, 28, and so on.
- 9.3 Non-finishers - 5 points less than lowest placed finisher
- 9.4 National competitors (any one that competes or has competed at a national event outside of the Northern Regions from 2016 to 2019 inclusive) will count their best 14 (fourteen) results
- 9.5 Regional and club competitors will count their best their best 15 (fifteen) results
- 9.6 There must be a minimum number of 3 eligible starters for championship points to be scored

10. SEPERATION OF TIES

A tie will be resolved in favor of the competitor having the greatest number of wins, then seconds then thirds etc. If the tie is not resolved then the competitor with the highest position for the last heat of the last event counting towards the Championship.

11. ANNOUNCEMENT OF POINTS AWARDED

Scoring for each event will be published on www.kart.co.za no later than seven (7) working days following the event. The secretary must receive any objection concerning the scoring, in writing, not later than seven (7) days following the publication of the scoring.

12. AWARDS

Trophies / awards will be awarded as follows:













• 6 Competitors in class - 3 trophies 4 Competitors in class - 2 trophies • 3 or less in class - 1 trophy

Awards will be based on the number of entries received by close of business the Monday prior to the race meeting.

13. DECLARATION OF CHAMPIONS

The Rand Kart Club Committee, at its sole discretion, is responsible for declaring the winners of the Class or to withhold such declaration.

- 13.1 Junior Victor Laudorum is open to competitors from the Bambino, Micro Max, Mini Max, Mini Rok, Junior Max classes.
- 13.2 Senior Victor Laudorum is open to competitors from Senior Max, Max 175, DD2 and DD2 Masters.
- 13.3 Point Scoring for Junior and Senior: The final points from the MSA NR Regional Championship will be added to the best ten (10) heats scored in the MSA Karting National Championships. The person with the highest number of points is the winner.
- 13.4 A Rookie Trophy will be awarded in each class for the highest placed competitor in the Rand Kart Club club championship in his/her first FULL racing season in that specific class.

14. AMENDMENTS

The Controllers reserve the right, without prior notice to introduce any regulations and/or to amend the existing regulations. Any amendments to these rules will be made in writing.
