1. Entry procedure / General information

Please note that the **entry form** has been published on the FIM Website. **Please download it and complete completed electronically** in capital letters. **Any handwritten form will not be considered nor registered:**

4. Entry Form

Each FMN can enter one Team of three riders in the 2019 Monster Energy FIM Motocross of Nations.

Any rider participating in this meeting must be holder of:

- the passport of the country he represents;
- a FIM Motocross World Championship licence / licence valid for the entire year or for one FIM meeting issued by any FMN;
- a starting authorisation to participate in the event from the FMN that issued the rider's FIM licence.

To be eligible for participation in the 2019 Monster Energy FIM Motocross of Nations and in order to obtain a FIM Licence for the first time during the current year, the riders must personally sign the "Acknowledgment and Agreement of the FIM Anti-Doping Code" form.

All forms from under-age applicants must be counter-signed by their legal guardians.

It is the task of the FMNs to collect the "Acknowledgement and Agreement of the FIM Anti-Doping Code" forms. Please follow this link to download it:

5. FIM Anti-Doping Form

Riders who already hold a 2019 FIM Motocross World Championship licence and have completed and signed an "Acknowledgement and Agreement of the FIM Anti-Doping Code" form this year do not have to complete and sign another.

Please note that the rider should always have with him a copy of his "Acknowledgement and Agreement of the FIM Anti-Doping Code", which has been certified by his FMN. We suggest that he keep this copy with his FIM licence.

Entries for the 2019 Monster Energy FIM Motocross of Nations must be made before the closing date for entries: 27th August 2019.

Entries must be made by means of the official entry form. This entry form must always be signed by the riders. Moreover, it must be approved by the FMN of each rider. Consequently, the entry form must bear the stamp(s) of the FMN(s) concerned.

Please make sure that you complete all the compulsory fields. Do not forget to mention a contact person for the Team together with his/her email and telephone details.

When completing the entry form, please note that the order in which you present your riders will automatically place them in the corresponding class and Qualifying Group (MXGP, MX2, "Open").



The age limits for the different classes of the 2019 Monster Energy FIM Motocross of Nations are the following:

- MXGP: Minimum age: 16 years Maximum age: 50 years
Riders born between: **1st January 1969 and 27.09.2003**
- MX2: Minimum age: 15 years Maximum age: 50 years
Riders born between: **1st January 1969 and 27.09.2004**
- Open: Minimum/Maximum age: depending on the class of the rider's motorcycle

The limit for the minimum age starts at the date of the rider's birthday.

The limit for the maximum age finishes at the end of the calendar year in which the rider reaches the age of 50 years.

Once the entry form has been duly completed as requested, it must be sent to the FIM as soon possible to both of the following email addresses:

We understand that in some cases this may be a somewhat lengthy procedure. Therefore, we suggest that you already make a provisional entry by e-mail or fax before the closing date for entries for this meeting.

A provisional entry should provide the following information on the Team:

A. For each rider:

- Class (MXGP - MX2 - "Open")
- Name and first name
- Date of birth
- Nationality
- FMN that issued the FIM Motocross World Championship licence
- FIM licence number (if already known)
- Motorcycle

B. For the Team Manager:

- Name and first name

This provisional entry must then be confirmed by forwarding us the duly completed and approved official entry form.

Teams/Riders may be required to sign an individual entry form during the administration control if necessary.

2. Team Press Information Form

YouthStream and the FIM must receive the duly completed Team Press Information Form for each team participating in the 2019 Monster Energy FIM Motocross of Nations.

3. Rider/Mechanic apparel and appearance

Please consult Chapter "2. Entries, riders and teams" of the FIM MXGP and MX2 Motocross World Championships and FIM Motocross of Nations Regulations.

Please note the rule concerning the riders' helmets:

- It is recommended that the helmet's overall colour scheme represent the colours of the team's national flag. The national flag can be replicated in stripes, bands or other designs.
- In addition, the defending FIM Team World Champion is allowed to wear the rainbow colours on the helmet.
- The overall pattern on the helmet - including its colour scheme, the stripes and bands or other designs representing the national flag of the team and/or the use of the "rainbow" on the helmet (in the case of the defending Champions) - must always be approved by the FMN of the team.
- The rider's personal sponsors may be integrated into the overall pattern or displayed in a separate area under the lower end of the strap of the goggles (horizontal line). Consequently, the helmet of each of the riders may be different, but the pattern of the helmet of each rider of a single team must have a similar visual appearance.

Please note the rule concerning the riders' team jerseys:

- Riders must display the FIM Championship logo (L 70 mm x W 35 mm) on the upper front torso or shoulder area of their jersey or on their chest/back protector if the latter is worn over the jersey.
- It is recommended that the equipment and protective clothing's overall colour scheme represent the colours of the team's national flag. The national flag can be replicated in stripes, bands or other designs.
- In addition, the defending FIM Team World Champion is allowed to wear the rainbow colours on the equipment and protective clothing.
- The overall pattern on the equipment and protective clothing - including its colour scheme, the stripes and bands or other designs representing the national flag of the team and/or the use of the "rainbow" on the equipment and protective clothing (in the case of the defending Champions) - must always be approved by the FMN of the team.
- The upper (visible) half of the jersey will display the logo(s) of the FMN and/or FMN's sponsor(s) (which cannot be in conflict with the rider's and his team's sponsors).



- The lower (visible) half of the jersey will display the logo(s) of the rider's and his team's sponsors.
- The sleeves of the jersey will display the logo(s) of the rider's and his team's sponsors.
- The back of the jersey will display the rider's name and number.

4. 2019 FIM Logo, number plates and starting numbers

We would also like to inform you about the 2019 FIM Motocross of Nations logo (new logo!), which must be displayed on the jerseys and the motorcycles (front number plate).

A copy of the 2019 FIM Motocross of Nations logo is attached to this letter. However, the logo and the visual identity guidelines are also available from YouthStream. Please contact YouthStream/Mr Hans-Martin Fetzter: sportoffice@mxgp.com.

As for the colours displayed on the motorcycle's front number plate:

A. For the winning Team of the previous year's FIM Motocross of Nations:

The motorcycle's side number plates must always display:

- The Team's national flag, respecting the dimensions of the number plate, as well as the starting number of the rider.

6. FIM Fuel Regulations

Only fuels corresponding to the FIM Specifications as set out in the FIM Technical Rules under "Art. 01.63 Fuel, oil and coolants" can be used. Any other fuel is illegal and thus not authorised by the FIM. Please consult the current FIM Motocross Technical Rules on the FIM website.



7. Travel indemnities and prizes

After the meeting, the FMN of each Team that participated in the 2019 Monster Energy FIM Motocross of Nations will be paid the travel indemnity and any prize money earned by FIM bank transfer on behalf of YouthStream (transfer description: 2019 FIM Motocross of Nations).

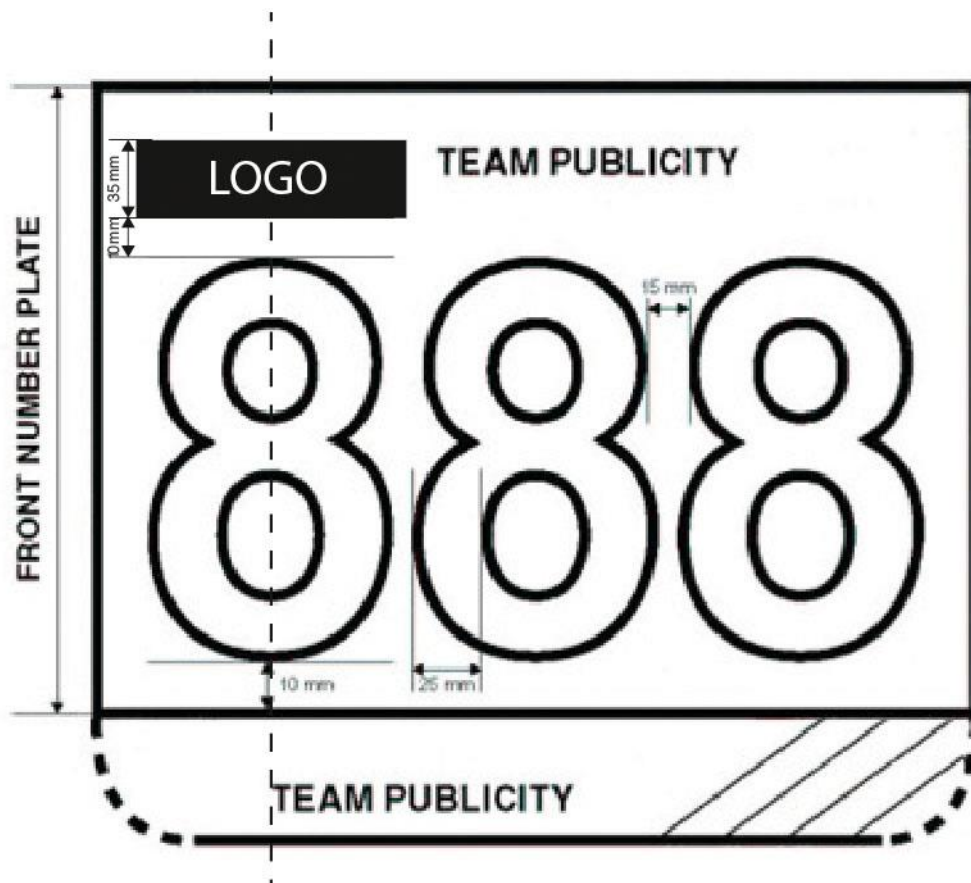
