<b>4. COURSE AND VENUE:</b>

<b>5. ELIGIBILITY OF RIDERS:</b>
a) The Championship is open to all Drivers who are domiciled in the area under jurisdiction of the MSA Western Cape Regional Committee, and whose karts and licences comply with the below specifications and regulations.
b) Competitors must refer to 2019 George Club Regulations ( <b>161862/144</b> ). All drivers must hold a minimum of a valid Annual or One Event MSA Social Karting licence.

<b>7. COMPETITION NUMBERS:</b>
Competition numbers for all classes will be issued by the George Dirt Karting Committee. (Refer to point 12.14 of the George Dirt Karting Club Regulations)

<b>8. CONTROLLERS:</b>
The controllers of the Championship shall be the George Dirt Karting Committee.

<b>9. RIDING GEAR:</b>
Protective clothing must be worn by all competitors as set out in point 9 of George Dirt Karting Club Regulations.



#### 10. ENTRIES:

For an entry to be valid, a completed official entry form must be with the organiser by the closing date. Proof of payment or entry fees need to be attached to the entry form (Refer to GCR 95).

Entries received without proof of payment will not be included in programme, and an additional R100.00 late payment fee will be added to the entry fee as a late administration fee – **THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED**

Entries Open - **Immediately** Entries Close - **02 November 2019 at 12:00**

Telephonic Entries **will not** be accepted

The Programme will not include entries received after **01st November 2019**

Late entry fee (applies to entries received without payment as well entries received on race day) **Full entry fee plus R 50.00**

Late registration fee (ie after documentation has closed) **Full entry fee plus R 50.00**

A maximum of 40 Karts will be accepted per combined races. If more than 40 karts are received those entries will be placed on a reserve list. Only if entries are withdrawn will the reserve list come into play. Drivers who are on the reserve list may change to any other class that they may be eligible to participate in, at the discretion of the COC.

#### 11. ENTRANT'S LICENCES:

Where the entrant is NOT the rider, an entrant's licence must be obtained from MSA and submitted together with the entry form, failing which the Entrant's name will not be published in the regional programme.

#### 12. ENTRY TO CIRCUIT:

Entrance to the grounds will be free for a (1) Driver and a (1) mechanic – The mechanic must accompany the Driver and the machine.

As decided on by the organising club, all other persons will have to pay an entry fee in the amount of **Adults –R10**  
**Children – R10**

#### 13. DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINEERING:

Refer to race programme in point 34.

**Drivers late for documentation will be charged an additional R100.00**

Scrutineering refer to point 6 of the 2019 George Dirt Karting Club Regulations.

#### 14. DRIVERS BRIEFING:

Refer to race programme in point 34.

All DRIVERS must be present at the briefing at the stipulated time and venue. Representatives may accompany the driver to the briefing, but may not represent the driver. Failure to attend the riders briefing may result in a fine of R100-00.

#### 15. PRE RACE PADDOCK / WAITING ZONE:

The Pre-race paddock / Waiting Zone is situated **Before the gates**

Before the scheduled start time of the first heat, competitors competing in the race concerned should move to the pre-race paddock / Waiting Zone.

#### 16. STARTS:

The start of the race will be in accordance with point 10.1 (c) in the 2019 George Dirt Karting Club Regulations.

If a driver is not present in the pre-race paddock when he/she is called to the start line, he/she will forfeit his/her starting position.

Competitors who do not take part in official practice must confirm their intention to start to the COC, no less than one hour before the start of the first heat.

A change of vehicle will be permitted subject to valid reasons for the change being given and the jury of the meeting agreeing to the change. (Refer to GCR 259)

#### 17. END OF THE RACE:

The waving of the chequered flag will signify the end of each race.

(Refer to point 8 (c) in the 2019 George Dirt Karting Club Regulations.

The MSA Steward / COC reserves the right to impound and examine any kart at their discretion.

#### 18. NOTICE BOARD:

The official notice board is situated at **The Kart Dummy Grid**

#### 19. RESULTS:

Notwithstanding the general protest period laid down in the GCR's, the protest period for dirt karting will be 15 minutes from actual posting of the FINAL results on the notice board. (Refer to results GCR 276)

These results are not to be removed and disciplinary action will be taken against any person removing these results without authority. Additional copies may be obtained from the Secretary of the meeting.



## **20. PRIZEGIVING:**

The prize giving will take place as soon as possible following the last heat and after the results become final.

Dead heats will be resolved as per GCR 275.

Competitor's attention is drawn to GCR's 274, GCR 280 and GCR 281.

Any drivers not attending prize giving will forfeit his/her prize unless suitable arrangements are made with the Race Secretary or Sponsors Representative

## **21. TROPHIES / PRIZE MONEY**

## **22. POSTPONEMENT, ABANDONMENT OR CANCELLATION:**

The Organisers reserve the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the meeting or any part thereof. In the event of any of the above, the Competitor/Entrant has no right to claim against the Promoter/Organiser in respect of any loss or damage he/she may incur, other than that specified in GCR 244. The meeting will not be postponed, abandoned or cancelled without the consent of the Jury President in accordance with GCR 152.

## **23. DRIVING CONDUCT:**

## **24. KARTS IN THE PITS:**

Refer to point 7 in the 2019 George Dirt Karting Club Regulations. Notwithstanding the exclusion, he/she will be reported to the Officials of the meeting who may consider further action in terms of a breach of GCR 172 (vii).

## **25. ADVERTISING:**

## **26. POINTS:**

Points will be scored as per point 10.2 in the 2019 George Dirt Karting Club Regulations.

## **27. PROTESTS:**

All protests and appeals will be dealt with as set out in GCR Appendix R, Parts IX and X.

## **28. MINIMUM NUMBER OF STARTERS:**

A minimum number of 4 starters for Club Championship classes must take part. If less than 6 entries are received in any of the club classes, that particular class may be combined with another class and competitors must nominate which class they would like to be scored in for the year.
