MSA CIRCULAR 1 OF 2016

1. Please refer to 2016 CROSS COUNTRY STANDING SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1.1 General: Wherever a reference is made to the President of the Cross Country Racing Commission, it may also include the CEO of SANORA and vice versa.

2. Please refer to REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO CROSS COUNTRY RACING - PART I: APPLICABLE TO ALL EVENTS

- 2.1 Change the following in **ART 311 SERVICE CREW/OUTSIDE ASSISTANCE** 311 [iii] Replace: Refer SSR 318 A [viii] c) with Refer SSR 318 A [vii] a)
- 2.2 Change the following in **ART 318 PENALTIES** Transfer: SSR 318 A [viii] c) (exclusion), to 318 A [vii] a) (sixty minutes) Transfer: SSR 318 A [viii] i) (exclusion), to 318 A [vii] d) (sixty minutes)

3. Please refer to REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO CROSS COUNTRY RACING - PART II: CLASSIFICATION AND VEHICLE SPECIFICATIONS

3.1 Art 1.5

Change the last sentence to: To qualify as a model, the vehicle should have produced and sold in quantities exceeding 2500 1000 in one year in commercial dealer outlets in South Africa.

3.2 Art 5 SAFETY, LIGHTING AND EQUIPMENT

For safety reasons regulation 5.2 requires yellow lights at the rear, as it provides more visibility in dust during close racing. Therefore the FIA class will have to conform to regulation 5.2 and fit yellow lights.

3.3 Art 8.1.22 TYRES

3.3.1 For the RFS Endurance event in Vryburg on 1 and 2 April, six new tyres will be allowed at the start of the season for this event only.

- 3.3.2 For the RFS Endurance Event, previously raced BF Goodrich competition tyres may be used, provided they are accepted by the Technical Delegate as previously raced and duly marked as such. Any previously raced and marked tyre may be raced until the tyre is worn out, or the marking has disappeared.
- 3.3.3 Commission Approved: All Production Vehicles, except in the FIA class, will have to race on Commission Approved tyres in the interest of cost saving. To be listed as Commission Approved, a tyre will have to be **freely** available over the counter from commercial outlets at a price of less than R5000-00 (incl VAT). Once listed, any competitor can use the tyre. Should the price escalate above R5000-00, the tyre will be removed from the list.
