MSA CROSS COUNTRY CAR CIRCULAR 1 OF 2019

1. Please note the following amendments to the **REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO CROSS COUNTRY CAR RACING – PART I: APPLICABLE TO ALL EVENTS**, which are of immediate effect:

a. Please refer to **1.1 of Art 304. ROAD BOOKS** and add:

[i] The Road Book takes preference over the route marking and any other navigational tools. *Where instructions are posted on Rallysafe, it will have equivalent preference to the Road Book. When speed limits in competitive sections are posted, it may not be exceeded. Exceeding the speed limit will be penalised by 5 minutes. Exceeding the speed limit by more than 10% will be penalised by an additional 5 minutes. Refer SSR 318 A [iii] h).*

b. Please refer to **1.2 of Art 318. A. PENALTIES** and add:

[iii] **Five (5) Minutes:**

h) For contravening SSR 304 [i] - exceeding the RallySafe demarcated speed limit in competitive sections. Five (5) minutes penalty and an additional 5 minutes for exceeding the speed limit by more than 10%, as verified by RallySafe. The Clerk of the Course may impose stricter penalties in the case of repeat offences. Refer SSR 304 [i].

2. Please refer to: **REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO CROSS COUNTRY CAR RACING – PART II: CLASSIFICATION AND VEHICLE SPECIFICATIONS**

a. Please refer to **2. of Art 4. EXHAUST SYSTEMS:**

Due to time constraints and rain in the Dullstroom area, the fitment of exhaust spark arrestors has been postponed to round 2. Competitors are however requested to ensure that their engine management systems are set to cut fuel on overrun, including the sequential gear flatshift, to minimize exhaust flame-spitting.
