## MSA NATIONAL CIRCUIT MOTORCYCLE CIRCULAR 5 OF 2019

The following circular serves as clarification regarding the 2019 National Circuit Motorcycle Regulations Art 13.12 and replaces Circulars 2 and 4 of 2019.

This circular details tyre brand, compound and type <u>for Rounds 2 and 3 only</u> of the 2019 South African National Superbike and Supersport Motorcycle Championship.

Following completion of Round 3 the tyre strategy will be re-evaluated and future direction communicated via a further official circular.

Official controlled tyre brand is Metzeler unless otherwise stated, compound and type as follows:

# 600 Class Dry Tyres:

120/70ZR17 Metzeler Racetec RR K1 180/60ZR17 Metzeler Racetec RR K1

#### 600 Class Wet Tyres:

120/70R17 Diablo Rain SCR1180/55R17 Diablo Rain SCR2190/60R17 Diablo Rain SCR1

## **Superbike Dry Tyres:**

120/70ZR17 Metzeler Racetec RR K1 200/55ZR17 Metzeler Racetec RR K1

## **Superbike Wet Tyres:**

120/70R17 Diablo Rain SCR1 190/60R17 Diablo Rain SCR1

### **Tyres General**

Pirelli wets to be used until further notice. Tyres are controlled. A maximum of three controlled tyres are allowed per meeting per competitor. Controlled tyres may only be purchased through SA-SBK. The onus is on the competitor to ensure controlled tyres are officially and correctly marked before exiting the pit lane.
