## MSA CIRCUIT MOTORCYCLE CIRCULAR 6 OF 2019

Riders of '300cc class' motorcycles shall be permitted, with immediate effect, to compete on circuit with other motorcycle racing classes that produce similar lap times, subject to the following:

- '300cc class' riders will be allowed to compete on circuit with other classes that produce similar lap times (such as the Powersport 400cc and 650cc classes and Historic motorcycles) from 01 January of the year in which they turn 14 (as per the published 2019 MSA national Supersport 300 regulations).
- 2. Riders under the age of 16 years shall be required to undertake and pass a written competency examination and provide proof of suitable previous racing experience (generally a minimum of one calendar year) in the 150cc short circuit racing class.
- 3. Reference is hereby made to SSR 1 (iii) a and b.
- 4. The 110% qualification rule see SSR 27 shall be strictly enforced for the '300cc class' riders in the interest of safety where classes have been combined.
- 5. The 2019 MSA national Supersport 300 regulations shall be applicable to all riders in this class, except for the upper age limits.
- 6. The relevant MSA regional motorsport committee shall have the ultimate discretion and authority with regard to decisions relating to the participation of '300cc class' riders together with other classes of motorcycle racing.
