MSA VW CHALLENGE CIRCULAR 2 OF 2020

The following amendment is made to the 2020 Northern Regions VW Challenge Regulations with immediate effect:

- 2.6.7.1 Any competitor who, for the first time in the 2020 Championship Season, joins any class in the last event of the series will be excluded from scoring championship points but will still classify as a starter.
- 15.25.5. Valve springs and retainers are free. All valve seats must maintain standard 45-degree seat angles. Only the valve seat material i.e. not the cylinder head material may be machined.

Due to excessive tyre wear experienced at the recent Phakisa event, Class A and B competitors will be allowed an additional two (2) new tyres for the Extreme Festival event taking place on 7 November 2020. These additional tyres must be new and unused in order to be marked by the TC before qualifying.
