The route is a GPS route with minimal marking; There will be a Time Trial for all riders on Friday the 1st of November 2019 to determine starting positions for the main race. Riders who don't complete the Time Trial will start at the back of the field. Main Race on the 2nd of November 2019 will be a mass start in rows of 30 riders based on the Time Trial results; The main race route will be a Hard Enduro starting at Chertsey Farm with the Bronze Loop to Ramasgate where there will be a 10 min decontrol; Gold and Silver riders will complete their respective loops back to the decontrol and they will have a further 10 minute decontrol; Gold, Silver, Bronze and Hobby riders will leave the decontrol taking the bronze route to the finish at Chertsey Farm. The top 10 riders of each class are to hand in their GPS's for Scruitiny after the event. | |

The meeting will not be postponed, abandoned or cancelled without the consent of the Clerk of Course in accordance with GCR 152.

14. ADVERTISING:

It is condition of entry that in addition to the advertising referred to in GCR 246, competing motorcycles shall also display the advertising, if any, as stipulated in the Championship and specifications for the class for which the motorcycle is entered.

15. **POINTS:**

Points will be scored as per Art 7 in the 2019 MSA SA National Enduro SSR's.

17. PROTESTS:

All protests and appeals will be dealt with as set out in GCR Appendix R, Parts IX and X.

18. RIGHTS OF THE CLERK OF COURSE:

The Clerk of the Course and/or the Stewarts of the Meeting have the right to call a halt to an event due to "force majeure" for any of the following, but not limited to, reasons:

- i) Extreme weather conditions
- ii) Serious or fatal accident
- iii) Sections of the route being deemed impassable owing to recent extreme weather or other unforeseen circumstances.
- iv) Dangerous circumstances for riders involving spectators or bystanders.
- v) Any other circumstances which the Clerk of the Course, in his sole discretion, deems to be dangerous or prejudicial to competitors.

19. CROSSING OF PUBLIC / DISTRICT ROADS:

As the organizer we have fully acquainted ourselves with Art 20 of the 2019 MSA SA National Enduro SSR's. We the organizers are also aware and have acquainted ourselves with the provisions of Section 317 of the Road Traffic Act and confirm that the event officials have been made aware of the above section. By allowing the event to proceed we accept that all requirements are complied with and where applicable all relevant permissions are in place.

20. GENERAL:

Safety Plan for the event will be available from the Race Secretary, as per the requirements of the Safety & Recreation Act 2 of 2010. Written permissions and Police Clearance Certificate will also be with the race secretary.

- -Every pit is required to have a Fire Extinguisher of at least 2.5kg capacity.
- -Every rider is required to use an Environmental Mat when refuelling
- -Failure to meet these requirements will result in a fine being imposed
- -Refuse Bags will be available at The Registration Table





- -Riders are expected to take their refuse bags with them when leaving
- Riders to carry rope, whistle, cell phone, Minor Repair Kit, Water, Nutrition and Sun Block.
- -Helmets are to be worn at all times by any person on a motorcycle that has its engine running.
