FIRST YEAR SUBJECTS:

• Reality of Righteousness

This is a study of Paul's letter to the Romans as a case study reflecting some of the major themes of Christian theology. This understanding should deepen the learner's appreciation of new creation realities.

The Old Testament 1

A study that looks at Israel's history through the Old Testament and the significance of the Law that God instituted.

New Testament 1

This course gives an overview of the New Testament Gospels by focussing on the uniqueness of each Gospel and the harmony between the four. We also study the importance on each gospel writer's vision of Jesus Christ and our response to them.

The Holy Spirit 1

Get to know the person of the Holy Spirit, how you relate to Him, His work, gifts and power in your life
