Rules of the race:

- Licensed a thletes must run with 2016 licences on back and front of the club vest.
- Entrants in the 10km event must be 14 years or older on the day of the race to enter.
- In addition to Overall (Open) prizes, participants will only be eligible for an age category prize in the age category
 they enter. Corresponding numerical age category tags must be wom on the front and the back of the club vest.
 Participants may enter the age category corresponding to their chronological age or any younger category down to
 senior.
- Temporary licensed participants are eligible for age category prizes provided they enter the relevant age group, wear
 the appropriate age tags and provide proof of age. Temporary numbers should be worn on the chest.
- Juniors born in 1997 or later wearing a junior or senior license must display their category tags to qualify for age group
 prizes. Juniors will count towards Open team prizes.
- Club colours must be worn to qualify for team prizes.
- No personal seconding will be allowed en route except at official refreshments stations.
- Entry cards must be in the athlete's possession during the race.
- All race officials and traffic authorities must be obeyed. Please do not litter.
- Walkers must wear "walker" tags.

Raceinformation:

- Registration at Cape Peninsula University of Technology grounds is from 05:30 to 06:50.
- All entrants must follow the instructions of the Race Marshals.
- Social walkers are welcome.
- The route is flat and fast.
- Tog bag facilities are available at own risk.
- Prize-giving will be heldat 09:00.
