The IAIAsa Western Cape branch is inviting you to a full day workshop on “The Development of and Implementation of Environmental Management Programmes” on the 27th February 2018. The event will be held at: Eskom Hall, Brackenfell, hosted by Eskom Western Cape Region and registrations will start at 07:30 with the event starting at 08:30.

Regulation 34 of the 2014 environmental impact assessment (EIA) regulations, as amended, prescribes that compliance auditing of an EMP<sub>r</sub> be undertaken. Such compliance auditing is inter alia to determine efficacy of measures implemented in protection of the environment. Yet the quality of many approved EMP<sub>r</sub>'s do not provide sufficient and appropriate management and mitigation measures; nor consider contractual and regulatory requirements; and provision of appropriate resources to implement the prescribed requirements.

This workshop therefore aims to provide a common understanding through:

- Shared learning on EMP<sub>r</sub> implementation
- Debate EMP<sub>r</sub> in context of broader environmental management
- Debate contents of effective EMP<sub>r</sub>
- Understand the perspectives and expectations from Authorities, Developers and Consultants

The keynote speaker is Eben van Schalkwyk, whose Masters research focused on how the quality of EMP<sub>r</sub>'s can be determined in the South African context.

The workshop will present experiences and understandings of various speakers representing a wide range of private and public entities – thus looking at EMP<sub>r</sub>s from a number of viewpoints.

The desired outcome of the workshop, apart from the discussion and knowledge sharing of the workshop itself, is to ensure environmental management practices implemented during construction support effective compliance monitoring and environmental protection.
