5 Age Categories

The following age categories will participate in the 2025 Gauteng North Championships:

- a) No athlete will be allowed to run outside of his or her age category.
- b) Only athletes aged 6 years or older on 31 December 2025 (born in 2019 or earlier) will be allowed to enter for the Championships.
- c) Under 20: Athletes must be aged 19 years or younger, but at least 18 years of

age on 31 December 2025 (born in 2006 or 2007).

d) Under 23: Athletes must be aged 22 years or younger, but at least 18 years of

age on 31 December 2025 (born in 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006 or 2007).

e) **Senior (Open)**: Born between 1991 and 2005

f) **Masters**: Any athlete who has reached his/her 35th birthday (Rule TR 3.1)

6 Entries

- a) All **Team entries** eg. High Schools, Primary schools, Clubs, Development Clubs must be done on the prescribed Excel-spreadsheet entry form and must be e-mailed to anticsza@gmail.com and to truterh@hseldo.co.za by no later than **13 August 2025 at 20:00**. These bulk entries must be accompanied by **proof of payment.**
- b) All **individual entries** to be done via the Google form. https://forms.gle/kf8rkZZN7ivGdNoW6
- c) Please note that all athletes (all age groups) entered for the Championships will be required to participate with an ASA license and should be in possession of a valid SA ID-number. Athletes may not run with another athlete's permanent license.
- d) Age category tags for Masters athletes (from age 35 years and older) as well as the Under 20 men and women (Junior, born 2006 & 2007) must be worn.
- e) Temporarily licenses (R70.00 each) and age tags (R20.00 a pair) will be available for purchase at the venue.

8 The Course

The Cross-Country course consists of a 2 km and a 1 km loop and the following will apply for the different distance races:

- The 1 km race will do 1 x 1 km loop
- The 2 km race will do 1 x 2 km loop
- The 3 km race will do 1 x 1 km loop, followed by 1 x 2 km loop
- The 4 km race will do 2 x 2 km loops
- The 6 km race will do 3 x 2 km loops
- The 8 km race will do 4 x 2 km loops
- The 10 km race will do 5 x 2 km loops

Course inspection will only be allowed on Friday, 15 August 2025 between 14:00 – 17:00.

For All Age Categories and Only during this time slot.

NOBODY will be allowed on the course on Raceday.

9 Officials Meeting

The Officials Meeting will take place as follows:

Time & Date: 06:30 on Saturday, 16 August 2026

Venue: Lavender Kontrei (Country) Market at Registration.

10 General

- a) The competition will be conducted under WA, ASA and AGN Rules
- b) <u>Technical Data</u>: Electronic timing will be used, and Videos.
- c) Athletes are not permitted to take any cell phones, ear pods, speakers, etc. into the competition area.
- d) Spectators will not be allowed to run with participants.
- e) During the competition, athletes must wear their ASA licenses (permanent or temporally) numbers on front and back, properly secured on all four corners.

Please note WA Rule 143.7-9. Any athlete who does not respect these rules will not be allowed to compete.

11 Athletes Control Centre (Call Room)

- Athletes are required to assemble at the call room 30 minutes prior to the start of their race.
 Refer official program for detailed times.
- a) The Call Room will be situated next to the starting area. All athletes must report to the Call Room at least 30 minutes before the start of their event. Refer to the official program.
- b) Only reporting athletes and authorized technical officials will be allowed inside the Call Room area. Parents, Coaches and Team Managers entering this area submit their athlete to the risk of disqualification.
- c) Parents, Coaches and Team Managers are responsible for the clothes and personal belongings of the athletes.
- d) Please make sure that athletes comply with all the requirements needed in the competition. This includes ASA license numbers (Front and Back), or Temporary license number, age category tags (Front and Back) and club or school attire.

12 Assistance to Athletes

- a) Water will be provided on the course at a water point near the 2 km split, for all races in excess of 4 km.
- b) Water will be provided at the finish line.
- c) No Seconding will be allowed by any person except for authorized officials.
- d) <u>Medical Service</u>: Full medical services will be available with two ambulances at the venue.

13 Victory Ceremony

- a) All finishing athletes will receive Participation Medals at the finish line (no ceremony)
- b) The first 3 athletes in each age category will receive Provincial Medals at relevant Victory Ceremony.
- c) The Victory ceremonies will be according to the program. The first 3 athletes in each individual age category must report to the Victory ceremony area 15 minutes before the allotted time (refer: Event Program).

d) Prize Money:

- No athlete will qualify for prize money if he or she did not participate in at least four
 (4) of the Cross-Country season leagues
- Athletes who represented SA Internationally during the season must have participated
 in at least two (2) of the Cross-Country season leagues to qualify for prize money.
 These athletes need to notify Hanlie Truter via e-mail, truterh@hseldo.co.za before
 the AGN Championship of the above-mentioned competitions.

14 Results

- a) Time for processing results may vary depending on the number of athletes and categories within a race. Generally, results will be made available approximately 45 minutes after completion of the race.
- b) Appeals must be done in writing (Forms will be available at Registration) within 30 minutes after the results were displayed on the "Results Board" or published on the Official WhatsApp Results group. Cost of the appeal will be R500-00.
- c) The results of each event shall be displayed on the "Results board" at the venue and posted on the Official Results WhatsApp group, after approval by the Chief Referee.
- d) Joining the WhatsApp groups will be via QR registration posted around the venue or by the following link https://chat.whatsapp.com/EVEQ7GNbtzwCBi16byav5z.
- e) A full set of results will be made available after the competition.
