#### 4) Entries

All entries must be done on the prescribed Excel-spreadsheet entry form and must be e-mailed to truterh@hseldo.co.za and buksmeyer@vodamail.co.za by no later than **15 August 2023 at 21:00.** 

Athletes are required to assemble at the call room 30 minutes prior to the start of their race.

Please note that all athletes (all age groups) entered for the Championships will be required to participate with an ASA license and should be in possession of a valid SA ID-number. Athletes may not run with another athlete's permanent license.

Age category tags from age 35 years and older as well as the junior men and women (born 2004 & 2005) must be worn.

Temporarily licenses and age tags will be available at the venue.

Clubs gazebos will be allowed at the clearly marked designated area

#### 5) Entrance Fees

Entrance fee for all athletes is  $\underline{R50} - \underline{00}$  per person and is payable into the account of Athletics Gauteng North by the closing date of entries - 15 August 2023.

The following age categories will participate at the 2023 Gauteng North Championships:

- a) No athlete will be allowed to run outside of his or her age category except in the following cases:
  - i. Senior (Open): Born between 1989 and 2003
  - ii. Under 23: Only athletes 22 years and younger, but at least 18 years of age on 31 December 2023 (born in, 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004 or 2005).
  - iii. Junior athletes must be 19 years or younger, but at least 18 years of age on 31 December 2023 (born in 2004 or 2005).

iv. Master Men and Women: Any athlete who has reached his/her 35th birthday (Rule TR 3.1)

Only athletes 6 years or older on 31 December 2023 (born in 2017 or earlier) will be allowed to enter for the Championships.

#### 7) The Cross Country Course

The course consists of a 2 km and a 1 km loop and the following will apply for the different distance races:

- a) The 1km race will be a short loop
- b) The 2km race will do one 2km loop
- c) The 3km race will do one 1km loop followed by one 2km loop
- d) The 4km race will do two 2km loops
- e) The 6km race will do three 2km loops
- f) The 8km race will do four 2km loops
- g) The 10km race will do five 2km loops

NB – Course inspection will be between 14:00 – 17:00, and not before these times, for all age categories on Friday, 18 August 2023. Nobody will be allowed on the course on Saturday, 19 August 2023

#### 9) Publication of Results

- a) The results of each event shall be displayed on the "Results board" at the venue after approval by the Chief Referee (approximately 40 minutes after completion of the race).
- b) All information pre-Competition, During and Post Competition will be posted at regular intervals on a Designated Competition Website, the provision of WhatsApp results will also be published as soon a signed off by the designated referee for each Race. Joining the WhatsApp groups will be via QR registration.
- c) A full set of results will be e-mailed the Thursday after the competition.
- d) Appeals must be done in writing (Forms will be available at registration) within 30 minutes after the results were displayed on the "Results Board". Cost of the appeal will be R500.00

#### 10) Assistance to Athletes

- a) Water will be provided on the course at a water point ±80m past the start line.
- b) Water will be provided at the finish line.
- c) No Seconding will be allowed by any person except for authorized officials.

#### 11) Athletes Control Centre (Call Room)

- a) The Call Room will be situated next to the starting area. All athletes must report to the Call Room at least 30 minutes before the start of their event.
- b) Only reporting athletes and authorized technical officials will be allowed inside the Call Room area. Parents, Coaches and Team Managers entering this area submit their athlete to the risk of disqualification.
- c) Parents, Coaches and Team Managers are responsible for the clothes and personal belongings of the athletes.
- d) Please make sure that athletes comply with all the requirements needed in the competition. This includes ASA license numbers (Front and Back), or Temporary license number, age category tags (Front and Back) and club or school attire.

#### 12) Victory Ceremony

a) The victory ceremonies will be according to the program. The first three athletes in each individual event must report at the victory ceremony area 15min before.

#### 14) Technical Data

- a) Manual hand timing will be used.
- b) Videos will be made of all races.
- c) During the competition, athletes must wear their ASA licenses (permanent or temporally) numbers, properly secured on all four corners. Please note WA Rule 143.7-9. Any athlete who does not respect these rules will not be allowed to compete.

#### 15) Medical Service

a) Full medical services will be available with an ambulance at the venue.

#### 16) General

- a) The competition will be conducted under WA, ASA and AGN Rules
- b) Athletes are not permitted to take any cell phones, cassette recorders, radios, I-pods etc., into the competition area.
- c) Spectators will not be allowed to run with participants.
