Athletics Gauteng North (AGN) is pleased to confirm that the 2025 AGN Cross-Country Championships will be held on Saturday, 16 August 2025, at Lavender Kontrei Market, 106 Apache Road, Onderstepoort, Pretoria.

Entries

Team entries, including schools and clubs, must be submitted via the official Excel entry form. These must be emailed to anticsza@gmail.com and truterh@hseldo.co.za no later than Wednesday, 13 August 2025 at 20:00, and must be accompanied by proof of payment.

Entry Fees

- Athlete Participation: R50
- Spectators: R20 (children under 6 enter free)
- Temporary License: R70
- Age Tags: R20 per pair

Tickets may be purchased online through Webtickets or in-store at any Pick n Pay (including BP Express stores). Payments and entries will also be accepted at the venue, but we urge participants to arrive early to avoid delays.

Please be reminded that all athletes must wear a valid ASA license, with no athlete permitted to run under another athlete's license. Age category tags are compulsory for Masters and U20 athletes.
