The 2023 AGN Cross Country season is now on a full gallop and we are racing towards the AGN Cross Country Championships that will be taking place on Saturday, 19 August 2023 at Tshwane University of Technology (TUT), Pretoria West Campus.

Please note that the manual for the AGN Cross Country Championships with all the information will be shared soon but, in the meantime, we would like to highlight the following:

- 1. Entries must be done on the excel spreadsheet that will be available by 3 August 2023. Closing date for the pre-entries will be 15 August 2023
- 2. We urge all the clubs/schools to pre-enter their athletes. One person of the club/school will collect the race cards for all their athletes on the Friday, 18 August 2023 before the champs between 14:00 to 17:00 and on the day of the Championships Saturday, 19 August 2023 from 06:00.
- 3. All athletes should enter for the correct race and participate in the entered race, kindly look at the age categories on the program. Athletes will unfortunately not be selected if they participate in the wrong race.

- All entry fees must be made via EFT into AGN account. Please DO NOT forward proof of payment to the AGN office – clubs/schools and individual athletes must bring proof of payment when collecting race cards.
- 5. The AGN Cross Country Championships program will be available by 3 August 2023. The program is exactly the same as the SA Cross Country Championships program.
- 6. Course inspection will only be on Friday 18 August 2023 from 14:00 till 17:00.
 - a. Nobody will be allowed on the course before that time and nobody will be allowed on the course on Saturday.
- 7. All athletes must run with an ASA 2023 License number.
- 8. The AGN Cross Country Championships is open to all AGN athletes.
- Please be reminded that all athletes should have compete in a minimum of four AGN Cross Country League meetings PLUS the compulsory AGN Championships in order to be selected onto the AGN Cross Country Team that will be participating at the ASA Cross Country Championships in Nelson Mandela University, Gqeberha on Saturday, 16 September 2023.
