## **General Rules**

1. Athletes must participate in affiliated club or school colours. NB! NO PARTICIPATION IN PROVINCIAL COLOURS
2. Entries for Leagues will be done on the Track and Field (close 30 minutes before start of event)
3. NB. PLEASE TAKE NOTE THAT TO QUALIFY TO BE SELECTED FOR THE GAUTENG NORTH TEAM FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE ASA PRIMARY SUB YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIPS, ATHLETES MUST COMPETE IN AT LEAST ANY, 2 OF THE 4 PRIMARY SUB YOUTH MEETINGS (ANY EVENTS) AS WELL AS THE COMPULSORY AGN CHAMPIONSHIPS.
4. **To be selected for the AGN Team, qualification standards must be met during the AGN Championships.**
5. A maximum of 5 athletes per event will be selected for AGN Team.
6. All athletes not in possession of a permanent license number for 2025, must obtain a temporary license number at the gate for R70.00 per license. No athlete will be allowed to enter or participate without a license number. Permanent Licenses are available at the AGN office but can only be obtained via an affiliated club or school.
7. Both permanent licenses must be worn, except for jump events.
8. **All athletes selected for the AGN team must have a permanent license number to participate in the ASA Primary Sub-Youth Championship.**

## **Rules for AGN Club competition (7-13) during league meetings**

1. First 20 highest points of each club during each league meeting will count (ASA table).
2. The total of points scored in all league meetings will be used to determine the Club champion (7-13 years)
3. Turbo Javelin
  - a. Max run up meters: 11 Year age groups: 12 meters and 9 Year age groups: 8 meters
4. Start: Ages 7-13: One false start warning will be allowed.

## **The following procedures will apply during the season:**

- ENTRIES FOR LEAGUES CLOSE AS FOLLOWS:
  - Entries for Track events will be done on track (close 30 minutes before start of event).
  - Entries for Field events will be done at the field (close 30 minutes before the start of the event).
- Starting blocks are compulsory for athletes participating under age group 9 and older (Track events).
- Take note that AGN records (Track) will only be accepted if electronic timing was used during the meeting.
- Records (Leagues and AGN Championship) records are combined to ensure that only one AGN set of records will be used in future.
- The Meeting will be held under ASA & AGN Rules.
- Sick notes must be handed in before the league.
- NB! NO PARTICIPATION IN PROVINCIAL COLOURS DURING LEAGUES.

### **Entrance Fee at gate:**

- Athletes – R50.00 entry fee,
- R70.00 Temporary License (06 years till 13 years) \*
- Spectators - (including parking) – R40.00
- Children – R20.00 (not participating) Children under 3 – free entry

\*All athletes not in possession of a permanent license number for 2025 must obtain a temporary license number at the gate. No athlete will be allowed to enter or to participate without a license number. Permanent Licenses are available at the AGN office but can only be obtained via an affiliated club or school.

### **Rules for selection for Primary Sub Youth AGN team (7-13 years) for ASA PSY Championships at McArthur Athletics Stadium: (05/06 December 2025)**

- 1) Participation in at least 2 league meetings – any events
- 2) Participation in the AGN Championships is compulsory (14/15 November 2025)
- 3) Minimum qualification standard (attached) must be reached per item during the AGN Championships
- 4) A maximum of 5 athletes who reached qualification standards during AGN Championships and participated in at least 2 leagues will be selected for the AGN Team. If 5 athletes did not reach the qualification standard during AGN Championships, but did participate in a minimum of 2 leagues, it will be the selectors prerogative if 5 athletes will be selected or not.
- 5) All athletes must buy a permanent number if selected for the AGN Team that will participate at Potchefstroom
- 6) Temporary licences / permanent numbers are compulsory for age groups 7 and older during leagues and AGN championships.
- 7) Sick notes must be handed in latest on the day of the league.
