RACE RULES AND INFORMATION

The entrants will participate under the rules of ASA and AGN; it is the entrants responsibility to familiarise themselves with the rules.

- Athletes participate at own risk and indemnify the organisers, sponsors, provincial and national bodies against any claims that may arise.
- Licenced athletes must wear their 2022 licences at the back and front of their vests participating in the 10km and 21.1km races.
- Unlicensed athletes in the 10km and 21.1km races must purchase temporary licence and wear it on the back of the vest.
- Race numbers must be worn on the front. The race number must not cover the logo on the ASA licence number.
- Athletes competing for age category prizes must display the official numeric age category tags on the front and back of their vests.
- Minimum ages for participants in the 10km is 14 years and in the 21.1km is 16 years on the race day.
- All category winners must provide proof of age to qualify for prizes
- Marshalls and Traffic Officials must be obeyed at all times. Failure to comply with their instructions may lead to immediate disqualification.
- No seconding is allowed during the race.
- No IPods or listening devices are allowed during the race.
- No Blade, Bicycle or mechanically operated device will be allowed in the race.
- Entry fees will not be refunded, returned, cancelled or exchanged on account of the weather or any unforeseen circumstances beyond the control of the event organisers.
- Cut-off times: 10km is 2hrs and 21.1km is 3hrs.
- No pets are allowed.
- There will be refreshment points at 3km intervals along the route.
- Medical support and Tog bag facilities will be available

COVID Compliance:

All Covid Regulations applicable must be observed.
