A loving Father gives his children only one set of guidelines to live by, yet sadly, many ignore this truth, thinking that God reveals himself in different religions, when in fact, he reveals himself in only one, and there can be only one.

We must not forget that Satan comes disguised as an angel of light¹¹, deceptively making evil look good and spurring the creation of false religions with false claims: religions that so many blindly follow, yet cannot deliver on their promises and prophesies, perform no miracles or healings, have not been able to raise people from the dead and cannot cast out demons from people¹². ¹³ According to one of the Vatican's most experienced exorcists, Fr Gabriel Amorth, in his book *An Exorcist – More Stories*, the twelve steps of a satanic pact in a black mass, a mockery of the Holy Eucharist, include: abjuring Christian Baptism; abjuring all the faith in the Eucharist; refusing obedience to God and accepting the will of Satan, Lucifer or Beelzebul; rejecting the Virgin Mary; rejecting the Catholic Sacraments; stepping on the Cross; stepping on images of the Virgin Mary and the saints; swearing eternal allegiance to the prince of darkness by swearing on diabolical scriptures; being baptised in the name of the devil, and choosing an appropriate name; receiving on the thigh, by means of a diabolical imprint, the mark of a sect; choosing a godfather and a godmother within the sect; profaning the Host (Body of Christ) without profaning the Tabernacle, that is, receiving Communion and preserving the Sacred Particles, which will be desecrated in a black mass.

In the words of Mother Mary to Alan Ames¹⁴:

Has anyone except the Lord Jesus come back to life and shown what follows death? Has anyone other than the Lord Jesus foretold his death and resurrection? Has anyone except the Lord Jesus defeated death? This is the proof that the Lord Jesus is the true Son of God and is the true way to heaven. Has any other sent the Holy Spirit to fill his children with gifts and graces of God? Has anyone but the Lord Jesus said you will heal and raise the dead in his name and fulfilled his promise? Has anyone else except the Lord Jesus said demons will flee from his name, and fulfilled his promise? Has anyone else made so many saints that showed his love? Has anyone else appeared over and over for nearly two thousand years to proclaim God's love? Has anyone else performed so many miracles? Has anyone else lived eternally? And has anyone else loved man so that he gave his life for the forgiveness of their sins? Who else has done these things? Who else has proclaimed the greatness of God with his every breath?
