# Unite your sufferings with Jesus to enter heaven



“And all that will live godly in Christ Jesus, shall suffer persecution.” (2 Timothy 3:12)

“And if sons, heirs also; heirs indeed of God, and joint heirs with Christ: yet so, if we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified with him. For I reckon that the sufferings of this time are not worthy to be compared with the glory to come, that shall be revealed in us.” (Romans 8:17–18)

*“Custodiet rectorum salutem, et proteget gradientes simpliciter, servans semitas justitiae, et vias sanctorum custodiens. Tunc intelliges justitiam, et iudicium, et aequitatem, et omnem semitam bonam.”*  
(Proverbs 2:7-9)

- DR: “**He will keep the salvation of the righteous**, and protect them that **walk in simplicity**. Keeping the paths of justice, and guarding the ways of **saints**. Then shalt thou understand justice, and judgment, and equity, and every good path.”
- NIV: “He holds success in store for the upright, he is a shield to those whose walk is blameless, for he guards the course of the just and protects the way of his faithful ones. Then you will understand what is right and just and fair – every good path.”
- NABRE: “He has success in store for the upright, is the shield of those who walk honestly, Guarding the paths of justice, protecting the way of his faithful ones, Then you will understand what is right and just, what is fair, every good path.”

[*salutem* = *saluto*: salute, hail, visit | *salutem* = *salus*: health, salvation, well-being, greeting, life]

[DR is not wrong, but better to say, “He will salute the righteous” because God’s aim is salvation for all.]

# “Abstinence”, “patience”, “godliness”, “charity” and “good works” have been removed

2 Peter 1:5–10

- DR: “And you, employing all care, minister in your faith, virtue; and in virtue, knowledge; and in knowledge, **abstinence**; and in **abstinence, patience**; and in **patience, godliness**; and in **godliness, love of brotherhood**; and in **love of brotherhood, charity**. For if these things be with you and abound, they will make you to be neither empty nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. For he that hath not these things with him, is blind, and groping, having forgotten that he was purged from his old sins. Wherefore, brethren, **labour the more, that by good works** you may make sure your calling and election. For doing these things, you shall not sin at any time.”
- NABRE: “For this very reason, make every effort to supplement your faith with virtue, virtue with knowledge, knowledge with self-control, self-control with endurance, endurance with devotion, devotion with mutual affection, mutual affection with love. If these are yours and increase in abundance, they will keep you from being idle or unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. Anyone who lacks them is blind and shortsighted, forgetful of the cleansing of his past sins. Therefore, brothers, be all the more eager to make your call and election firm, for, in doing so, you will never stumble.”
