As the Scriptures show, the angels in heaven have always been with us, in particular Archangels Michael, Gabriel and Raphael, who bring protection with their troops of angels. St Michael is well known for combating Satan and his evil spirits, St Gabriel is the messenger who

gives us strength and St Raphael brings healing upon us. Our guardian angels are always accompanying, guiding and shielding us from enemy attacks.

Meditations

Archangel Michael: “And there was a great battle in heaven, Michael and his angels fought with the dragon, and the dragon fought and his angels: And they prevailed not, neither was their place found any more in heaven. And that great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, who is called the devil and Satan, who seduceth the whole world; and he was cast unto the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him.” (Revelation 12:7–9)

Archangel Raphael: “Then the angel Raphael took the devil, and bound him in the desert of upper Egypt.” (Tobit 8:3)

Archangel Gabriel: “And the angel answering, said to him: I am Gabriel, who stand before God: and am sent to speak to thee, and to bring thee these good tidings.” (Luke 1:19)

Guardian angels: “There shall no evil come to thee: nor shall the scourge come near thy dwelling. For he hath given his angels charge over thee; to keep thee in all thy ways.” (Douay-Rheims Psalms 90:10 –11, others 91:10 –11)

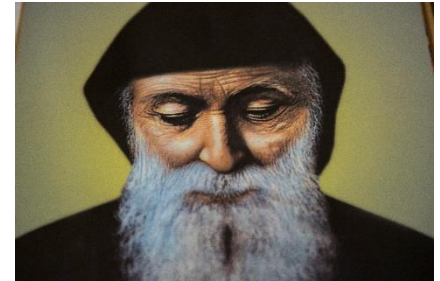
Judas Machabeus saw two deceased saints, Onias and Jeremiah, in a vision praying for the Jews, and, on their instruction, won the battle: “Now the vision was in this manner: Onias who had been high priest, a good and virtuous man, modest in his looks, gentle in his manners, and graceful in his speech, and who from a child was exercised in virtues, holding up his hands, prayed for all the people of the Jews: After this there appeared also another man, admirable for age, and glory, and environed with great beauty and majesty: Then Onias answering, said: This is a lover of his brethren, and of the people of Israel: this is he that prayeth much for the people, and for all the holy city, Jeremias the prophet of God. Whereupon Jeremias stretched forth his right hand, and gave to Judas a sword of gold,

saying: Take this holy sword a gift from God, wherewith thou shalt overthrow the adversaries of my people Israel.” (2 Machabees 15:12–16)

The ancients are powerful saints who also present other saints’ prayers for us to Jesus: “And when he had opened the book, the four living creatures, and the four and twenty ancients fell down before the Lamb, having every one of them harps, and golden vials full of odours, which are the prayers of saints.” (Revelation 5:8)

The key to becoming a saint: obedience, simplicity, humility

“For Moses was a man exceeding meek above all men that dwelt upon earth.” (Numbers 12:3)

“And the Lord said to him: Hast thou considered my servant Job, that there is none like him in the earth, a simple and upright man, and fearing God, and avoiding evil?” (Job 1:8)

“And whereas indeed he was the Son of God, he learned obedience by the things which he suffered: And being consummated, he became, to all that obey him, the cause of eternal salvation.” (Hebrews 5:8–9)

“Take up my yoke upon you, and learn of me, because I am meek, and humble of heart: and you shall find rest to your souls.” (Matthew 11:29)

All are called to be saints, but very few are obedient to their call

“My children must know, in this world, each one of my children is chosen for a task, especially to serve my Son Jesus Christ, not for his or her honour and glory. When my Son Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit place a gift of the Holy Spirit upon my children, there is a purpose, a task to be accomplished in each one of them. They must be obedient to their call. Sometimes there is a difference in their gifts that only in time they will discover their purpose in life and where to serve my Son Jesus Christ in his harvest.” (Mother Mary, 17/08/2017)



God wants unity in his Church of saints, not a loophole for division

*“Non enim est **dissensionis** Deus, sed pacis : sicut et in omnibus **ecclesiis sanctorum** doceo.”* (1 Corinthians 14:33)

- DR: “For God is not the God of **dissension**, but of peace: as also I teach in all the **churches of the saints.**”
- NABRE: “since he is not the God of disorder but of peace. As in all the churches of the holy ones.”
- NIV: “For God is not a God of disorder but of peace – as in all the congregations of the Lord's people.”

If you study John 7:43, John 10:19, Acts 15:39, Acts 23:7 and Acts 23:10, you will see the word “dissension” was either retained (where it suited) or obscured with other words to justify the Protestant break-up. In some Bibles, “dissension” has been replaced with “confusion”, which is a very different but “plausible” word.

Mercy, faith, purging of sins and God's call to obedience have been removed

*“Conturbat domum suam qui sectatur avaritiam; qui autem odit munera vivet. **Per misericordiam et fidem purgantur peccata, per timorem autem Domini declinat omnis a malo. Mens justi meditatur obedientiam; os impiorum redundat malis.**” (Proverbs 15:27–28)*

- DR: “He that is greedy of gain troubleth his own house: but he that hateth bribes shall live. **By mercy and faith sins are purged away: and by the fear of the Lord every one declineth from evil. The mind of the just studieth obedience:** the mouth of the wicked over floweth with evils.”
- NIV: “The greedy bring ruin to their households, but the one who hates bribes will live. The heart of the righteous weighs its answers, but the mouth of the wicked gushes evil.”
- NABRE: “The greedy tear down their own house, but those who hate bribes will live. The heart of the just ponders a response, but the mouth of the wicked spews evil.”
