2020 All Star VKC Club Championship

Standing Supplementary Regulations (162142)

1. Event:

All race meetings held under this championship shall be held under Motorsport South Africa (MSA) General Competition Rules (GCR's) for 2020, the 2020 Karting Regulations, the 2020 Northern Regions ROK, SARMC and Rotax Karting Championship Regulations of 2020 and any Supplementary Regulations issued by the club for each race day as well as any instructions issued from time to time in MSA circulars or bulletins.

- a. Vereeniging Kart Club and the VKC committee will be the controllers of the All Star VKC Championship in consultation with Motorsport South Africa.
- b. The controllers reserve the right, without prior notice, to introduce and / or amend the existing regulations should circumstances warrant and approval has been obtained through the committee as per the constitution of the club. All additions/amendments will be published on the Official Notice board and where possible circulated to competitors 5 days prior to any event.

2. Eligibility:

- a. The 2020 VKC Club Championship is open to **all** drivers from all clubs who possess an MSA Karting licence and adhere to the regulations set out in the 2020 Karting Regulations.

3. Validity:

- a. For the calendar year of 2020.

4. Aim of the Championship:

The aim of the VKC Club championship is to declare a Vereeniging Kart Club Champion in each of the nominated classes, whilst promoting a culture of good sportsmanship, fair play and recognition of all drivers without boundary of race, religion or culture, in a professional and fun environment.

5. Classes:

- a. Kid ROK
- b. Mini ROK
- c. OKJ – may use own motors. Hired motors are available from RokCup with no swapping of motors. Contact Kobie Coertze – info@rokcup.co.za
- d. Super ROK
- e. KZ2
- f. KZ
- g. Bambino
- h. Micro Max
- i. Mini Max
- j. Junior Max
- k. Senior Max / Master Max
- l. DD 2 / DD2 Masters

Depending on the number of entries on the day the organizers reserve the right to combine classes as necessary, and combined classes will be scored separately. There will be no split starts, unless as called for by the Clerk of the Course for the day.

6. Number of events:

- a. The championship will comprise of 5 rounds in 2020.
- b. Each event will comprise 3 heats per class on the day.
- c. Dates: 8 February, 19 April, 18 July, 12 September, 11 October (Sunday)

7. Scoring:

- a. Scoring will be as per the 2020 Northern Regions Rok and Rotax Karting Championships.
- b. The separation of ties at the end of the day and the end of the championships will be determined by the driver who has the most 1st place finishes then 2nd place finishes and so forth during the championship.

8. Equipment

The above listed championship classes will use equipment, weights and ages as per the 2020 MSA Karting National Regulations as well as the technical regulations for the individual classes which can be found on MSA's website www.motorsport.co.za
