



## 2020 CLUB ENDURO CHAMPIONSHIP REGULATIONS (162155/144)

### 1. **CONTROLLERS**

Club Name - Rover Motorcycle Club  
Controllers - Club Enduro Committee

### 2. **AIM OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP**

To declare a Rover Enduro Champion Motorcycle rider in each of the following classes:

- Junior 85cc
- 125cc (High School)
- E1 Class
- Open (E2) Class
- Senior Class
- Master Class

### 3. **VALIDITY OF REGULATIONS**

For the calendar year of 2020.

### 4. **REGULATIONS**

All qualifying events shall be held under the General Competition Rules (GCR's) and Standing Supplementary Regulations (SSR's) of Motorsport South Africa (MSA), these Standing Regulations and the Supplementary Regulations (SR's) issued by the Promoters.

### 5. **ELIGIBILITY**

- 5.1 Any motorcycle built for off road use is eligible.
- 5.2 Competitors must comply with the safety specifications for riders as per the 2020 MSA Hand Book and the motorcycle must comply with both safety and eligibility as per the 2020 MSA Hand Book.
- 5.3 All competition numbers must comply with MSA stipulations relating to size and colour.
- 5.4 The competitor's numbers will be those as issued by MSA (Head Office) only, contact Carmen on [carmen@motorsport.co.za](mailto:carmen@motorsport.co.za)

### 6. **DEFINITION AND DURATION**

The events shall be a test of riding skill and physical endurance of both rider and machine over an unseen cross country route or course. The events may incorporate or consist wholly of Regularity Stages or Racing Stages and Special Stages. The minimum distance of a qualifying event shall be 100km in length or three hours riding duration, whichever is the lesser.



**7. CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS**

As per the 2020 MSA Motorsport Calendar.

**8. MINIMUM STARTERS AND ELIGIBILITY OF RIDER**

- 8.1 For a Champion to be declared there must be an average of 3 starters per class calculated at the end of the season.
- 8.2 Classes which do not field the required average number of starters will be scored towards the championship standings and the average calculated at the completion of the championship.
- 8.3 No competitor may enter more than one class.
- 8.4 Competitors to hold a valid MSA Competition Licence for Enduro.

**9. CLASSES AND TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS**

- 9.1 Junior 85cc  
Open to riders from the year of their 8th birthday, to 31 December of the year in which their 13th birthday occurs.  
Motorcycle not exceeding 85cc 2 Stroke or 125cc 4 Stroke air cooled.  
Minimum wheel size 14" rear and 17" front. Maximum 16" rear and 19" front.
- 9.2 125cc (High School)  
Open to riders from the year of their 15<sup>th</sup> birthday, to 31 December of the year in which their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday occurs on motorcycle maximum permissible capacity 125cc 2 stroke.
- 9.3 E1  
Open to riders from the year of their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday.  
Two stroke from 125cc – 200cc and four stroke from 150cc – 250cc.
- 9.4 Open (E2)  
Open to riders from the year of their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday.  
Two stroke over 201cc and four stroke over 251cc.
- 9.5 Senior  
Open to riders from the year of their 36<sup>th</sup> birthday.  
Motorcycle open to any capacity.
- 9.6 Master  
Open to riders from the year of their 45<sup>th</sup> birthday and older.  
Motorcycle open to any capacity.
- 9.7 WOW  
The normal age and engine capacity rules need to be respected in the WOW class. Competitors who have held one or more WOW licence during two consecutive calendar years will no longer be permitted to take out any further WOW licences and will need to upgrade to a minimum of a club licence. This is a non-championship class.



## 10. POINTS SCORING

10.1 Points will be awarded for each of the events as follows:

- a) 5 points for starting the event.
- b) 5 points for finishing the event.

10.2 Championship points will be allocated as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup>	-	25 points	2 <sup>nd</sup>	-	22 points
3 <sup>rd</sup>	-	20 points	4 <sup>th</sup>	-	18 points
5 <sup>th</sup>	-	16 points	6 <sup>th</sup>	-	15 points
7 <sup>th</sup>	-	14 points	8 <sup>th</sup>	-	13 points
9 <sup>th</sup>	-	12 points	10 <sup>th</sup>	-	11 points
11 <sup>th</sup>	-	10 points	12 <sup>th</sup>	-	9 points
13 <sup>th</sup>	-	8 points	14 <sup>th</sup>	-	7 points
15 <sup>th</sup>	-	6 points	16 <sup>th</sup>	-	5 points
17 <sup>th</sup>	-	4 points	18 <sup>th</sup>	-	3 points
19 <sup>th</sup>	-	2 points	20 <sup>th</sup>	-	1 point

From 20<sup>th</sup> place on, one point to all finishers.

For the last round of the championship starting and finishing points will be doubled.

10.3 Riders competing who are ineligible for the Championship will be ignored for the purpose of scoring points for the Championship. Riders must reside in the region and also must be members of a registered MSA Off Road / Enduro Club in the region to be eligible to score in the championship and to be eligible for awards on the day.

10.4 A competitor who sets an event that counts towards this Championship may compete and obtain points as earned or may be granted average points for that event subject to the following conditions:

- a) The competitor is eligible to compete for this Championship
- b) A competitor may only get average points for TWO such events throughout the year
- c) Average points shall be calculated by adding the competitor's points for all the events held and dividing by one less than the total number of events held. If a competitor does not compete in any event, then the rider shall be deemed to have DNF'ed that event.
- d) No more than TWO competitors may receive average points for a particular event.

## 11. NUMBER OF EVENTS TO COUNT

All qualifying rounds will be scored in determining the final Championship positions; a minimum of 6 events will be run.

## 12. SEPARATION OF TIES

Refer to GCR 229 of the 2020 MSA Hand Book.



**13. POINTS**

Points scoring will be available on request from Rover Motorcycle Club Secretary. Points should normally be available on the second Monday following the event. The Controllers reserves the right to correct clerical errors at any time.

**14. DECLARATION OF CHAMPIONS**

The Controllers, at their sole discretion, are responsible for declaring the winner of the Championship or to withhold such declaration.

**15. REGULATIONS**

All qualifying events will be held under General Competition Rules (GCR's) and Standing Supplementary Regulations (SSR's) of Motorsport South Africa (MSA), MSA Circular(s) of 2020 and the Supplementary Regulations (SR's) issued by the organisers.

**16. ELIGIBILITY OF RIDERS**

The Club Championship shall only be open to Club Members and only from date of membership. No points scored during the racing year prior to becoming a member will count towards the Club Championships.

**17. FUEL**

Refer to ART 15 (c) in the 2020 National Enduro Regulations.

**18. SCRUTINEERING**

Refer to ART 15 in the 2020 National Enduro Regulations.

**19. SAFETY REQUIREMENTS**

Refer to the SSR 225 and 228 in the 2020 MSA Handbook.

**20. COMPETITION NUMBERS**

Refer to ART 14 of the 2020 National Enduro Regulations and any applicable bulletins issued by MSA in ALL regards.

**21. SEPARATION OF TIES**

Refer Art 7 in the 2020 MSA National Enduro Regulations and if this is ineffective Rover Motorcycle Club Enduro Committee will declare the winners on any basis they may deem fit.

**22. PENALTIES**

Refer to the GCR and SSR MSA Handbook 2020 and SR's for the day's event.



**23. PAYMENT AND ENTRIES**

Refer to SR's for each race date. Late entries, late payments and late arrivals for documentation will incur penalties. Any objection will be dealt with at the sole discretion of Rover Motorcycle Club Enduro Committee. Proof of payment must be emailed to the Club. No previous entry from a previous race date or membership at the Club guarantees entry to all races. Online entries on website [www.racecontrol.co.za](http://www.racecontrol.co.za) The Club reserves the right to reject an entry.

**24. ENTRANT'S LICENCES**

Where the entrant is NOT the rider, an entrant's license's must be obtained from MSA and submitted together with the entry form, failing which the Entrant's name will not be published in the programme. All competitors to present licenses at documentation. No Verbal license numbers will be accepted. No license NO RIDE.

**25. TROPHIES**

Junior Classes will receive trophies for 1st – 3rd  
Senior Classes will receive trophies for 1st – 3rd

**26. AMENDMENTS**

The Controllers reserve the right to introduce new Regulations and or amend the existing Regulations. Any such amendment / addition to the Regulations shall, however, only come into effect once it has been published on an official MSA circular / bulletin. Such changes to these Regulations **shall** be issued at least SEVEN (7) days prior to the next event being held. All additions / amendments will also be published on the official notice board at the next event.
