## REVIEW AND AMENDMENTS

ANY proposed / desired changes to these Championship Regulations must be submitted to the Controllers for approval. The Controllers reserve the right to introduce new Regulations and / or amend existing Regulations with the approval of Motorsport South Africa (MSA).

Amendments and updates to the rules will be recorded in the Amendment Record, detailing the updated version, date of approval of the amendment and a short summary of the amendment. The new version of the rules will be published by MSA at least seven (7) days prior to the next event being held unless a shorter notice period is approved by MSA.

All race meetings shall be held under the General Competition Rules (GCR's), Standing Supplementary Regulations (SSR's) of Motorsport South Africa (MSA), these Club Regulations, the event Supplementary Regulations (SR's) and any applicable Circulars of MSA for Enduro. In the event that the Club Rules are silent, the National Rules shall, at all times prevail.

**1. CONTROLLERS**

Club Name - Rover Motorcycle Club  
Controllers - Club Enduro Committee

**2. AIM OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP**

To declare a Rover Enduro Champion Motorcycle rider in each of the following classes:

- Junior 85cc
- High School
- E1 Class
- E2 Class
- Senior Class
- Master Class
- **Amateur Class**

**3. VALIDITY OF REGULATIONS**

For the calendar year of 2021.

**4. ELIGIBILITY**

- 4.1 Any motorcycle built for off road use is eligible.
- 4.2 Competitors must comply with the safety specifications for riders as per the 2021 MSA Hand Book and the motorcycle must comply with both safety and eligibility as per the 2021 MSA Hand Book.
- 4.3 All competition numbers must comply with MSA stipulations relating to size and colour.
- 4.4 The competitor's numbers will be those as issued by MSA (Head Office) only, contact Carmen on [carmen@motorsport.co.za](mailto:carmen@motorsport.co.za)

**5. DEFINITION AND DURATION**

The events shall be a test of riding skill and physical endurance of both rider and machine over an unseen cross country route or course. The events may incorporate or consist wholly of Regularity Stages or Racing Stages and Special Stages. The minimum distance of a qualifying event shall be 100km in length or three hours riding duration, whichever is the lesser.

**6. CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS**

As per the 2021 MSA Motorsport Calendar.

## **7. MINIMUM STARTERS AND ELIGIBILITY OF RIDER**

- 7.1 For a Champion to be declared there must be an average of 3 starters per class calculated at the end of the season.
- 7.2 Classes which do not field the required average number of starters will be scored towards the championship standings and the average calculated at the completion of the championship.
- 7.3 No competitor may enter more than one class.
- 7.4 Competitors to hold a valid MSA Competition Licence for Enduro.

## **8. CLASSES AND TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS**

- 8.1 Junior 85cc  
Open to riders from the year of their 8<sup>th</sup> birthday, to 31 December of the year in which their 13<sup>th</sup> birthday occurs.  
Motorcycle not exceeding 85cc 2 stroke cooled.  
Minimum wheel size 14" rear and 17" front. Maximum 16" rear and 19" front.
- 8.2 High School  
Open to riders from the year of their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday, to 31 December of the year in which their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday occurs on motorcycle maximum permissible capacity 125cc 2 stroke.
- 8.3 E1  
Open to riders from the year of their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday.  
Two stroke from 125cc – 200cc and four stroke from 150cc – 250cc.
- 8.4 E2  
Open to riders from the year of their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday.  
Two stroke over 201cc and four stroke over 251cc.
- 8.5 Senior  
Open to riders from the year of their 36<sup>th</sup> birthday.  
Motorcycle open to any capacity.
- 8.6 Master  
Open to riders from the year of their 46<sup>th</sup> birthday and older.  
Motorcycle open to any capacity.
- 8.7 WOW  
Age and engine capacity regulations as per the Enduro SSR's and must be adhered to at all times with regard to the WOW class (refer Article 12a) of the National Enduro SSR's).  
This is a non-championship class.

**The maximum distance for the WOW riders will be equal to 25% of the full distance for the senior classes (E1 & E2).**

## 8.8 Amateur

Open to riders from the year of their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday until 31 December of the year in which their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday occurs may only compete on 2 stroke motorcycles from 125cc – 200cc and 4-stroke motorcycles from 150cc – 250cc. Riders from the year of their 19<sup>th</sup> birthday may compete on any capacity motorcycle. The maximum distance for this class will be equal to 50% of the full distance for the senior classes (E1 & E2).

## 9. POINTS SCORING

9.1 Points will be awarded for each of the events as follows:

- a) 5 points for starting the event.
- b) 5 points for finishing the event.

9.2 Championship points will be allocated as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup> -	25 points	2 <sup>nd</sup> -	22 points
3 <sup>rd</sup> -	20 points	4 <sup>th</sup> -	18 points
5 <sup>th</sup> -	16 points	6 <sup>th</sup> -	15 points
7 <sup>th</sup> -	14 points	8 <sup>th</sup> -	13 points
9 <sup>th</sup> -	12 points	10 <sup>th</sup> -	11 points
11 <sup>th</sup> -	10 points	12 <sup>th</sup> -	9 points
13 <sup>th</sup> -	8 points	14 <sup>th</sup> -	7 points
15 <sup>th</sup> -	6 points	16 <sup>th</sup> -	5 points
17 <sup>th</sup> -	4 points	18 <sup>th</sup> -	3 points
19 <sup>th</sup> -	2 points	20 <sup>th</sup> -	1 point

From 20<sup>th</sup> place on, one point to all finishers.

For the last round of the championship starting and finishing points will be doubled.

- 9.3 Riders must be members of the Rover Motorcycle to be to score points in the Club Championship. Riders competing who are ineligible for the Championship will be ignored for the purpose of scoring points for the Championship.
- 9.4 A competitor who sets an event that counts towards this Championship may compete and obtain points as earned or may be granted average points for that event subject to the following conditions:
- a) The competitor is eligible to compete for this Championship
  - b) A competitor may only get average points for TWO such events throughout the year
  - c) Average points shall be calculated by adding the competitor's points for all the events held and dividing by one less than the total number of events held. If a competitor does not compete in any event, then the rider shall be deemed to have DNF'ed that event.
  - d) No more than TWO competitors may receive average points for a particular event.

## 10. NUMBER OF EVENTS TO COUNT

All qualifying rounds will be scored in determining the final Championship results.

## 11. SEPARATION OF TIES

Refer to GCR 229 of the 2021 MSA Hand Book.

**12. POINTS**

Points scoring will be available on request from Rover Motorcycle Club Secretary and on the MSA website, [www.motorsport.co.za](http://www.motorsport.co.za)

**13. DECLARATION OF CHAMPIONS**

The Controllers, at their sole discretion, are responsible for declaring the winner of the Championship or to withhold such declaration.

**14. ELIGIBILITY OF RIDERS**

The Club Championship shall only be open to Club Members and only from date of membership. No points scored during the racing year prior to becoming a member will count towards the Club Championships.

**15. FUEL**

Refer to ART 15 (c) in the 2021 National Enduro Regulations.

**16. SCRUTINEERING**

Refer to ART 15 in the 2021 National Enduro Regulations.

**17. SAFETY REQUIREMENTS**

Refer to the SSR 225 and 228 in the 2021 MSA Handbook.

**18. COMPETITION NUMBERS**

Refer to ART 14 of the 2021 National Enduro Regulations and any applicable bulletins issued by MSA in ALL regards.

**19. SEPARATION OF TIES**

Refer Art 7 in the 2021 MSA National Enduro Regulations and if this is ineffective Rover Motorcycle Club Enduro Committee will declare the winners on any basis they may deem fit.

**20. PENALTIES**

Refer to the GCR and SSR MSA Handbook 2021 and SR's for the day's event.

**21. PAYMENT AND ENTRIES**

Refer to SR's for each race date. Late entries, late payments and late arrivals for documentation will incur penalties. Any objection will be dealt with at the sole discretion of Rover Motorcycle Club Enduro Committee. Proof of payment must be emailed to the Club. No previous entry from a previous race date or membership at the Club guarantees entry to all races. Online entries on website [www.racecontrol.co.za](http://www.racecontrol.co.za)

**22. ENTRANT'S LICENCES**

Where the entrant is NOT the rider, an entrant's license's must be obtained from MSA and submitted together with the entry form, failing which the Entrant's name will not be published in the programme. All competitors to present licenses at documentation. No Verbal license numbers will be accepted. No license NO RIDE.

**23. TROPHIES**

As per the event SR's.
