2022 Provisional FIM JuniorGP™ Technical Regulations

The FIM and FIM Europe have published the provisional technical rules that will regulate the 2022 FIM JuniorGP™.

The articles amended as from December 2021 are in bold green type or strikethrough.

In the coming weeks, the complete regulations, including not only the Technical Regulations, but also the Sporting and the Disciplinary Regulations will be released.

The FIM was the first international sports federation to impose an Environmental Code in 1994.
