2020 Calendar UPDATE 24 APRIL

Dutch and Czech rounds cancelled

Due to the ongoing pandemic of the Coronavirus, and the extension of the restrictions put in place by the local government in the Netherlands and the Czech Republic concerning the ban on organising sports events, the FIM, the promoter APO Multimedia, the Dutch Motorcycling Federation (KNMV), the Autoklub of the Czech Republic (ACCR) and the local organisers regret to announce the cancellation of the rounds which were rescheduled to take place in Oss (NED) on 14 June and Kramolin (CZE) on 21 June.

As the situation remains in a state of constant evolution, we will continue to monitor and to communicate in a timely manner if further schedule changes are required.
