## FIM CEV Repsol Moto3™ Junior World Championship 2020 Calendar Update 23 MARCH - Season opener at Portimao postponed

Due to the ongoing coronavirus outbreak, Round 1 of the FIM CEV Repsol has been postponed.

The event was set to take place from the 23<sup>rd</sup> to the 26<sup>th</sup> of April at Autódromo Internacional do Algarve, and will now be rescheduled for later in the year.
