## FIM E-Bike Enduro World Cup & FIM EX-Bike World Cup 2020 Calendars UPDATE 04 August

### 2020 FIM E-Bike Enduro World Cup cancelled

Following recent meetings and after careful discussions regarding the difficulties caused by the Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic at the organisational level, the FIM, the Belgium Motorcycle Federation (FMB), the French Motorcycle Federation (FFM) and the local organisers have been forced to cancel the Belgium and French rounds which were scheduled to take place at Lac de l'Eau d'Heure (BEL) and at Charade (FRA). In light of this a decision was made to focus on next year and to postpone the FIM E-bike Enduro World Cup in 2021.

The FIM EX-Bike World Cup will take place as originally planned at the Two-Off Circuit, Boves/Cuneo, Italy on 18 October 2020.
