FIM Long Track World Championship

2020 Calendar UPDATE 20 APRIL

Given the ongoing circumstances and governmental restrictions associated with the Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic, the FIM, the French Motorcycling Federation (FFM), the German Motorcycling Federation (DMSB) and the local organisers regret to announce the cancellation of Finals 2 & 3 that were respectively scheduled to take place on 20 June, in La Réole (FRA) and on 05 July Muhldorf (GER).

Unfortunately it will not be possible to reschedule these events; all parties continue to monitor the situation and will communicate about the updated calendar once it is possible and appropriate to do so.

The FIM is an independent association formed by 112 National Federations throughout the world. Among its 50 FIM World Championships the main events are MotoGP, Superbike, Endurance, Motocross, Supercross, Trial, Enduro, Cross-Country Rallies and Speedway. Furthermore, the FIM is also active and involved in the following areas: public affairs, road safety, touring and protection of the environment. The FIM was the first international sports federation to impose an Environmental Code in 1994.
