French round postponed to 5 September 2020

2020 Provisional calendar, UPDATE 12 March

As a result of continued coronavirus-related health concerns and the French health minister's ban on gatherings of more than 1,000 people, The FIM, the promoter Santander Salt Limited and the organizer Automobile Club de l'Ouest have postponed to 5 September, the French round initially scheduled to be held on 18 April 2020 .
