FIM Sidecar World Championship 2021 Provisional calendar, UPDATE 09 February September Bol D'Or date cancelled for 2021

The FIM, RKB-F1 Motorsport and Santander Salt organisations regret to announce the cancellation of the sixth round of the Championship scheduled to run alongside the Bol D'Or in September.

Despite the best efforts of the promoter and organisers, due to staffing and other problems associated with the COVID 19 pandemic, it has not been possible to negotiate sufficient track time or paddock facilities alongside the WEC World Endurance round. Both parties are extremely disappointed, but there is mutual intent and desire to plan for 2022.

RKB-F1 Motorsport is actively seeking a suitable replacement and will advise of such at the earliest opportunity.
