2021 Calendar UPDATE, 05 May

Qualifying Round in Manchester cancelled, Latvia to take place in Daugavpils

The FIM, national federations and local organisers involved have been forced to make the following changes to the FIM Speedway U21 World Championship 2021 calendar:

- The Qualifying Round in Manchester, Great Britain is cancelled due to the impact and restrictions associated with the ongoing pandemic.
- The Qualifying Round that was originally set to take place in Riga, Latvia has changed venue for technical reasons and will now take place in Daugavpils on June 12.
