FIM X-Trial World Championship & Prize

2021 Provisional Calendars, UPDATE 02 February

Due to the evolution of the current pandemic, some dates have been rescheduled. The events originally scheduled in Wiener Neustadt (Austria) on March 20 and in Nice (France) on April 9 have been removed from the calendar due to the lack of availability of alternative dates in the arenas where they were to be held.

In light with the current situation the FIM X-Trial des Nations will not take place in 2021.
