MSA NATIONAL KARTING CIRCULAR 8 OF 2020

To all competitors participating in the SARMC and in particular the National event at iDube on 22nd and 23rd of August 2020

In order to keep costs down as far as possible the following has been decided:

Tyres:

1. From the start of official practice on Friday only 1 (one) set of new tyres or 1 set of used tyres, registered with the organizers, must be used.
2. For qualifying and races only one set of new or the same set of used tyres used in practice may be used.
3. New tyres must be purchased from the organizers.
4. To be clear a maximum of two sets of tyres, (new or used) both registered with the organizers may be used for the duration of the event.
5. If you elect to make use of used tyres these must then be the same set that was registered with the organizers and used throughout practice and qualifying. In other words you then will elect to use only one set of tyres.
6. Tyre pricing: the pre-covid tyre prices remain in force while stocks last for C2, D2 and W3 tyres however the new batch of D5 tyres (used in Senior Max, DD2 and DD2 Masters and identifiable by a yellow band and marked D5 CIK) will cost R 3950.00 inclusive of VAT with immediate effect. The weakening of the Rand had a drastic effect on the cost which we can unfortunately not absorb.
7. New D5 tyres are freely available for practicing **only** and competitors must note that these may **not** be used at the Cape Town Regional event on 15th August 2020. Technically the tyre is unchanged but being "fresh" might be a little faster. Random tyre scanning will take place at this event and anyone using incorrect tyres will be excluded."
8. The same regulations will apply at Zwartkops and Cape Town National events for 2020
