REGIONAL COLOURS CRITERIA

The following are the criteria applicable to the awarding of Regional Motorsport Colours by MSA.

1. COMPETITOR COLOURS

- i) A competitor may only receive the Regional Colours of the motorsport region in which he/she is permanently domiciled.
- ii) Competitors will be considered for the award of Regional Colours in a given year if they are recognised by MSA as being the winner of a MSA-sanctioned National Championship, National Challenge, Interprovincial Challenge or Regional Championship in the year in question.
- iii) Competitors who are 16 years old and under as at 31 December of the year under consideration and who qualify in terms of point 1 ii) above, shall receive Junior Colours.

2. NOMINATIONS

- i) The relevant MSA Regional Committee shall make recommendations to MSA ManCom regarding the awarding of regional colours as and where necessary.

3. GENERAL

- i) Colours shall only be awarded once (except where a competitor qualifies to receive Senior Colours after having previously earned Junior Colours) and shall not reflect either the category of motorsport or the year concerned.

4. ADMINISTRATION COLOURS

- i) Colours awarded will embody the same emblem as for competitors, with the addition of a scroll stating "Administrator".
- ii) The nominee must be currently active in the administration of motorsport at Regional Championship level and/or higher.
- iii) The nominee's period of service to the sport should be a minimum of five (5) years, not necessarily consecutively.
- iv) Written nominations detailing the nominee's services to the sport must be submitted to the MSA's Operations Manager by end October of the year under consideration.
- v) MSA ManCom (in consultation with interested parties as deemed appropriate) will adjudicate on the nominations received and its decisions shall be final.

Note: This document takes effect from the 2021 racing season and does not apply retrospectively.
