This result giving us a 2nd for the days racing.

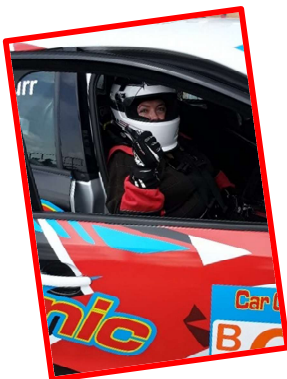


A second overall for the year
