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## **eLearning**

- eLearning has been introduced to assist in learning mSCOA online at your own pace (the course should take about 5 days if you do it full-time)
- The platform is easily accessible through Computers, Cellphones, etc.
- The course will be available for all government and municipal officials at a reasonable fee (NSG indicated R300.00)
- mSCOA training material and the platform has been developed to accommodate the web-based environment
- Videos for different modules, and units have been embedded on the platform for further illustration of different topics
- Circulars and other legislations supporting specific sections or learning outcomes are attached for enhancing the training material and better understanding of the course
- eLearning is still at pilot stage to ensure that development is a success before it can be rolled out
- Municipalities will be informed once the platform is ready, and registration is open by March 2022.

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## **Course structure**

The course is structured as follows:

## Module 1 – The fundamentals of mSCOA

- An overview of the Local Government Budget and Financial Management Reform Agenda and mSCOA Legislative Framework
- mSCOA implementation oversight (including the role of internal audit, risk management and councilors)
- Understanding the mSCOA segments

## Module 2 - System and reporting requirements

- An overview of the reporting requirements in a mSCOA environment.
- Key business processes that underpins mSCOA
- Minimum system specifications required to comply with the *m*SCOA Regulations
- Submission of documents and data strings to the National Treasury (i.e., registration process and upload process)
- Period Control and how to transact and report in period 13, 14 and 15
