**Venue:** Green Point Cricket Club. Parking is available in the surrounding area. There will be one refreshment station, in the transition area. Coke and water will be provided as each runner finishes. Medical backup services will be provided. Toilets will be available. Tog bag facilities will be provided (at runner's own risk). Clubs are welcome to erect gazebos on the field.

**Registration & Late Entries:** At the race venue from 16:30. Entries are Limited to 120 Teams (500 Runners).

Categories & Prizes: Team Categories: Club (Men, Ladies, Mixed), Vets (Men, Ladies, Mixed), Junior (Boys & Girls), Masters and Kids. Mixed teams must consist of at least two ladies. To qualify for Club category prizes, teams must consist of licensed runners from the same club and runners must wear official club colours. Teams consisting of unlicensed runners or licensed runners from different clubs will compete in the Corporate (Men, Ladies, Mixed) categories and will be placed but will not be eligible for category prizes. Junior (14-19) and Kids (u/14) team members do not have to be licensed or belong to the same club or school, nor do they have to be licensed.

All finishers will receive a special hand-made medal!

## Rules:

- The race will be run in accordance with the rules of ASA and WPA. Detailed rules are available on www.wpa.org.za or on request from the organisers or the WPA office.
- 2. Participants must be 9 years or older on the day of the race.
- One SSTTT race number (bib) will be issued. Registered athletes must wear their 2018 ASA licenses on the front and back of their vest. The SSTTT race number must be worn on the front of the vest, partially covering the ASA license, so that the ASA license sponsor remains visible.
- All traffic officers and marshals must be obeyed.
- Athletes may enter and compete for more than one team but only one of the teams will be eligible for a prize. (The second team they compete for will not be eligible for prizes)
- For safety reasons the use of personal music players with headphones is not allowed and may result in disqualification.
- 7. The Winning Team in each category will receive prizes.
- Mixed Teams must consist of at least 2 ladies. Teams with 3 or more males will compete in the Men's Category.
- Ladies Teams must consist of 4 Females.

- All runners in Vets Teams must be over the age of 40 on the day of the event. Masters must be over 50 and Grand Masters over 60.
- 11. Mixed Junior teams will compete in the Junior Boys category.
- 12. There will be NO prizes for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> placed teams in any category.
- 13. The race organisers reserve the right to accept or reject any entry.
- 14. Kilometre markers will be placed at each kilometre mark.
- Do not litter. Dispose of sachets and cups responsibly by using the boxes provided or by carrying then to the Finish. Report offenders to the referees.
- No personal seconding will be permitted, except at the official refreshment station.
- 17. The Water / Coke station will be in the transition area.
- 18. The entry fee is non-refundable.
- The cut-off time for the race is 1 hour 30 minutes. All 4 runners must complete the race within this time.
- An entry card and category tag must be in the athlete's possession during the race.
- Athletes must run with the baton and / or timing chip provided, which must be handed from one runner to the next.
