Circular 105 of ASA 2017 (09/05) – LIST OF TRACK AND FIELD EVENTS WHERE ATHLETES CAN QUALIFY FOR 2018 COMMONWEALTH GAMES

On 4 September 2017 (ASA Circular 104), ASA announced the ASA Squad in preparation for the 2018 Commonwealth Games.

Athletes not listed in the Preparation Squad and/or Preliminary Team for the 2018 Commonwealth Games, have the right to appeal for reconsideration in writing, to ASA at Hezekiel@athleticssa.co.za; att. Hezekiel Sepeng, before close of business on Friday 15 September 2017. The appeal should consist of the performance of the athlete, as well as the date and event of the achievement. Athletes without an ASA Permanent License cannot appeal.

With reference to <u>ASA Circular 100</u>, the 16 events llisted below are confirmed events where athletes can qualify for the 2018 Commonwealth Games. These events will be monitored by ASA to ensure that the performances of athletes are eligible. Please note that the results of events <u>not</u> listed below, may not be considered for selection purposes.
