Circular 82 of ASA 2017 (07/25) – THERAPEUTIC USE EXEMPTIONS (TUEs)

SAIDS (South African Institute for Drugfree Sport) has ask ASA to inform all professional athletes of the importance to adhere to the TUE (Therapeutic Use Exemption) Rules and Regulations.

ASA are in the process of amending the ASA Domestic Rules and Regulations accordingly.

Until the mentioned Rules and Regulations has been amended and adopted by the ASA Council, ASA request Members to assist in informing all Event Organizers of events listed on the ASA National Fixtures list, of the importance of athletes entering their races to adhere to TUE (Therapeutic Use Exemption) Rules and Regulations.

It is recommended that Race Organizers add to their marketing material (fliers) the following:

“Athletes, entering for this event, and use medication to treat an illness or condition which fall under the Prohibited List, should complete a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) form before entering for the event and obtain authorization from SAIDS to take the needed medicine or method.”
