Circular 95 of ASA 2017 (08/14) – SASA AND USSA TO SERVE ON PROVINCIAL BOARDS

The ASA AGM held on 17 June 2017, with specific reference to the President's report, it was reported to the ASA Members that ASA has challenges in reporting accurately on development and transformation statistics to SRSA.

As a result, the EPG Report that ASA submit to SRSA, reflects a distorted view of development and transformation of athletics in South Africa.

A clear example is the ASA Youth Team that finished 1st on the medal tally at the 2017 IAAF World Youth Championships; and the ASA Senior Team that finished 3rd on the 2017 IAAF World Championships medal tally, both reflects positive growth of demographics and transformation statistics.

Yet, when ASA derive statistics from the ASA Licenses data base, the statistics on demographics and transformation reflect negative growth.

The main source of this discrepancy mentioned above is as a result of USSA and SASA not fully aligned with ASA. As a result the registration and licensing of athletes which USSA and SASA represent does not reflect correctly on statistics derived from the ASA Licensing network.

To correct the above challenge, all provinces were requested during the 2017 ASA AGM, to ensure that both USSA and SASA are represented on the Provincial Boards along the same lines as the ASA Constitution, and therefor become part of decision making at all levels of athletics in South Africa.
