## RACE RULES & INFORMATION

- 1. Licensed runners / walkers must wear official club colours and display unaltered license numbers valid for 2018 on the front and back of their vests. Unlicensed participants must also purchase a Temporary License at R35,00 (Seniors) & R20,00 (Juniors), in addition to the entry fee, which must be worn on the front of their vest. Temporary licensed athletes should wear plain clothing without any advertising.
- Temporary license holders, when registering, must complete and hand in the tear-off strip from the number in order to be eligible to compete.
- 3. Minimum age for the 10km is 14 years. For the Fun Run all children under 9 years must be accompanied by an adult.
- 4. Participants must obey the instructions of marshals and Traffic Officers.
- 5. Entry cards must be carried for the duration of the race. Any participant not able to produce an entry card when asked to do so by a race official may be disqualified. Finish sachet with Entry card to be handed in at the Results board at the Finish.
- 6. No personal seconding will be permitted except at official refreshment stations.
- 7. Juniors (born from 1999 onwards) wearing a junior or senior license must display category tags "J" on the front and back of their vests to qualify for age group prizes. Juniors will count toward Open team prizes.
- 8. Club colours must be worn to qualify for team prizes.
- 9. Temporary licensed athletes are eligible for age category prizes provided they entered the relevant age group, wear the appropriate age tags and provide proof of age.
- 10. In addition to Overall (Open) prizes, participants will only be eligible for an age category prize in the age category they enter. Corresponding numerical age category tags must be worn on the front and back of their vest. Participants may enter the age category corresponding to their chronological age or any younger category down to Senior.
- 11. Any ruling by the race committee will be considered final.
- 12. Race run in accordance with the rules of ASA & WPA.
- 13. For safety reasons the use of personal music players with headphones during road races is not allowed. Any person using such a device in contravention of ASA Rule 34.10.6 may be disqualified.
- 14. Participants take part at their own risk and the organisers will not be held responsible for any accident or injury resulting from the athlete's participation.
- 15. No race numbers will be issued.
- 16. Online entrants can collect their race cards at Pre-entries on Saturday from 10h00 16h00 or at registration on Sunday morning.
- 17. This is a Run Clean event. Please do not litter. Use the litter boxes provided to dispose of water sachets or carry it to the finish.
- 18. A Tog bag area will be provided at own risk. Do not leave valuables in your car!
- 19. Wheelchair athletes must please contact the organisers timeously to discuss arrangements for their participation.
