KING & QUEEN OF THE HILL

R500 awarded to the **first male and female** to summit the famous race hill (approx. summit distance – 5.5km) and finish in the top 5.

ENTRY RULES

- The race is run according to the rules of ASA and WPA.
- Participants in the 10km must be 14 years of age or older and participants in the 5km must be 8 years of age or older on race day unless accompanied by an adult.
- Race numbers (bibs) will not be issued. All
 registered athletes must wear two valid license
 numbers. Unregistered participants must
 purchase a Temporary License which must be
 worn on the front of the vest.
- 4. Temporary license holders when registering **MUST** complete and hand in the tear off strip from the number to be eligible to compete.
- Licensed athletes should wear club colours. Temporary licensed athletes must run in clothing without advertising.
- To qualify for team prizes, athletes must wear full club colours and participate with a permanent license.
- Age category tags must be worn (front and back) and visible for the entire race to be eligible for any age category prize.
- Entry cards, when issued, must be in the athlete's
 possession during the race and handed in at the
 results board at the Finish.
- 9. Cut off for all races is at 08h45. Prize-giving is at 09h15.
- Do not litter. Dispose of sachets and cups responsibly by using the boxes provided or carrying them to the Finish. Report offenders to the referees. #RunClean
- 11. The use of music players with headphones is not allowed and will result in disqualification.
- 12. Detailed rules are available on www.wpa.org.za or on request from the organisers or the WPA office.
- Wheelchair athletes must please contact the organisers timeously to discuss arrangements for their participation.
- 14. A tog bag area will be available at own risk.
- 15. Juniors (born in 1999) wearing a senior or junior licence must display category tags "J", to qualify for age group prizes. Juniors will count towards Open team prize.
- 16. No personal seconding will be permitted except at official refreshment stations.
- 17. Liability: The organizers and sponsors accept no responsibility for injury or accident resulting from participation in the race.
- 18. The use of music players with headphones is not allowed and may result in disqualification.
