## **DIRECTIONS TO THE START**

Drive up Old Cape Road towards St Albans Prison for 5.6km past the new Makro. Turn left into Draaifontein Road just past the Greenbushes Garage. Continue along Draaifontein Road for 3km and turn right into Fairview Racecourse main entrance.

### BUS SERVICE

A bus service will be available from Kings Beach Parking area to the start of the race for any athlete wishing to make use of the service. Bus tickets must be purchased in advance before the closing date on Tuesday 29 November 2022. A return bus ticket will be R50.00 per person. Out of town athletes are therefore encouraged to book accommodation close to Kings Beach, Gqeberha. Buses will depart at 04h30 and return at 12h00. Security at Kings Beach will be provided.

## **SCHOOL SHOE DRIVE**

Athletes are encouraged to either purchase a pair of school shoes for primary school children (Size 0 – 5) and bring it to registration, or to make a donation towards the shoes when entering. Each athlete donating will be entered into a special lucky draw for a new pair of Nike Running Shoes. Please help us to support the local community.

#### **GENERAL RACE INFORMATION**

- 1. Organized in accordance with the rules and regulations of ASA and EPA. All athletes indemnify the National, Provincial and Regional bodies, sponsors and organizers against all and any actions of whatsoever nature.
- 2. Online entries are available on <a href="https://www.webtickets.co.za">www.webtickets.co.za</a> until Tuesday 29 November 2022.
- 3. Entries can be submitted to Brian Bands Sports in Cape Road and UD Sports in Uitenhage. Closing date for entries will be Tuesday 29 November 2022.
- 4. The race committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.
- 5. Collection of race numbers and late entries will be available at the Kings Beach on Friday 2 December 2022 between 15h00 and 20h00 and at the start of the event at Fairview Racecourse from 04h30 until 05h30 on the morning of the event.
- 6. Please NOTE that Kings Beach is not near the actual race venue but it at least 20km towards Jeffreys Bay.
- 7. Bus tickets from Kings Beach parking area to the start will be available. Tickets must be purchased online before the closing date on Tuesday 29 November 2022. Out of town athletes are encouraged to book accommodation near Kings Beach, Gqeberha. Busses will leave Kings Beach at 04h30.
- 8. Entry fees are non-refundable. A receipt/proof of payment may be required in case of any discrepancy with pre-entries.
- 9. All traffic Officials and marshals must be obeyed.
- 10. The wearing of earphones or headsets is not permitted due to safety reasons and may lead to disqualification.
- 11. Medals will be awarded to all finishers.
- 12. 42.2km and 21.1km race will start at 05h30 from the Fairview Racecourse, Draaifontein Road, Greenbushes.
- 13. The minimum age is as follows: 42.2km 20 years / 21.1km 16 years.
- 14. The cut off time for the 42.2km is at 11h00. And the cut-off for the 21.1km is at 09h00.
- 15. EPA Championship medals will be awarded to the top 3 EPA licenced athletes in each age category for the marathon. Relevant age category tags must be visible front and back of the vest.
- 16. Club gazebo's are welcome. No club cooler boxes are permitted. Please support the Racecourse vendor. The venue has a liquor licence and therefore no alchohol may be brought onto the premises.
- 17. Athletes must run in official Club colours with the Official race number on the front and 2022 licence number on the front and back of the vest.
- 18. Athletes who are not licensed members of a club affiliated to ASA must purchase a temporary license to be worn on the back of the vest.
- 19. Age category tags must be visible on front and back of your vest if you wish to qualify for category prizes. Athletes may be requested to provide proof of age on race day.
- 20. Registered athletes are covered by a group personal insurance scheme. Temporary licenced athletes have no cover and are urged to join an affiliated club.
- 21. Please obey parking marshals.
- 22. Athletes must run facing traffic at all times, unless instructed otherwise by a marshal.
- 23. No personal seconding will be allowed on the route for the first 21.1km.
- 24. Refuse bins will be placed up to 500m after the water stations. Please discard all litter (sachets/bottles/cups/other) into the bins provided and not beyond the designated points. Disposing litter outside the demarcated zone may result in disqualification.
- 25. Relevant Covid-19 regulations will apply.
